

## **Georgia STD Quarterly Surveillance Report January – March, 2014 - 2016**

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STD Program  
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All Georgia physicians, laboratories, and other health care providers are required by law ([OCGA 31-12-2](#)) to report patients with the conditions listed under [Notifiable Disease Reporting Requirements](#). Syphilis is reportable immediately upon diagnosis; chlamydia and gonorrhea within 7 days. Both laboratory confirmed and clinical diagnoses are reportable within the specified time interval. Reporters are encouraged to report into the Georgia State Electronic Notifiable Disease Surveillance System (SENDSS).

Disease reporting enables public health follow-up for patients and helps identify outbreaks. This is particularly important to do in a timely way for any disease or condition that may require immediate public health intervention. Disease reporting also provides a better understanding of disease trends and patterns in Georgia to support program and policy decision-making and resource allocation.

The Georgia Department of Public Health STD Program provides this data report to educate residents, private and public health professionals and other interested parties about the numbers of STD cases in Georgia. This report shows reported chlamydia, gonorrhea and syphilis (all stages) cases by county of residence at time of report in Georgia, Quarter 1, January – March, 2014 - 2016. These data compare quarterly data over the past three years, which may provide an indication of disease trends. However, for more detailed analyses to identify definite trends larger time periods are needed. Readers should consider the 2016 data in this report to be preliminary since some of these cases are considered presumptive and their status may change as case investigation continues.
