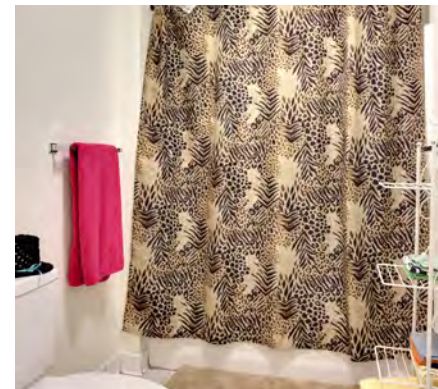

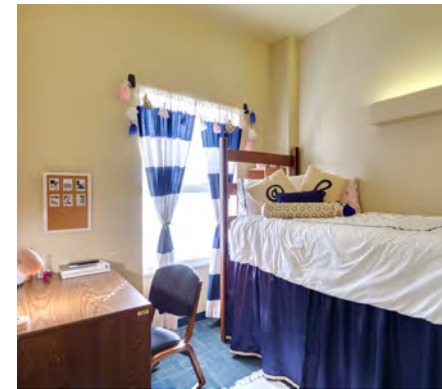
APARTMENT STYLE

Apartment style bedrooms are furnished with an extra-long twin bed, chest of drawers, desk, desk chair, and wardrobe.

Each living room includes a sofa, end table, coffee table, and a dining table with chairs. The kitchen comes equipped with a stove, microwave, refrigerator, and dishwasher. Bedrooms and living area have either carpet or wood laminate flooring.

A rising second-year student is one who matriculated at Georgia Tech in summer 2019, fall 2019, or spring 2020, and who was accepted as a freshman according to admission records.

You are considered a rising second-year student even if your class status is a sophomore, junior, or senior due to your AP credit hours.

- Senior (90+ hours)
- Junior (60-89 hours)
- Sophomore (30-59 hours)
- Freshmen (0-29 hours)

Room assignments are made using a room selection number based on your class status and the number of credit hours earned at Georgia Tech at the end of the fall semester.

Students who have the same ranking will be randomly sorted.
