- The courses start on **Tuesday** of the first week.
- 1 unit (teaching unit) = 45 minutes
- We offer German courses in **11 different phases** (A1/1 – C2/1). Each course covers one phase.
- All new participants are required to take a **placement test** unless they are complete beginners or can produce an ÖSD or Goethe Institut Certificate issued within the last 12 months. Please note that in order for the certificate to be accepted, the scores for each of the four language skills (listening, reading, writing and speaking) must be at least 80%.
- At the end of each course, **certificates** are issued to participants who have attended classes regularly ($\geq 75\%$ attendance) and who have taken the final exam. **4 ECTS** credits are awarded to students who successfully complete the course.
- **Textbooks** are available at the Facultas bookstore on campus or as e-books on the publishers' websites worldwide. They are not included in the course fees.

Editorial

Our popular summer German courses will take place both **online** and **offline** at our course locations on or near campus in 2021. This means that you can choose the most suitable option, and, if necessary, learn German with us from anywhere in the world. Our highly qualified and experienced teachers offer lively, interactive lessons and support you in achieving your learning goals.

Accommodation in student residences

If you wish, we can book you a single room in a student residence at a convenient location (basic facilities). Meals are not provided. You will find numerous inexpensive restaurants near campus.

Rooms can only be reserved for the entire duration of the course (27 nights in July/August, 20 nights in September). Arrival is consented only on Sunday before course start, departure on Saturday after course end.

When booking two or three courses, the nights between courses will be charged extra.

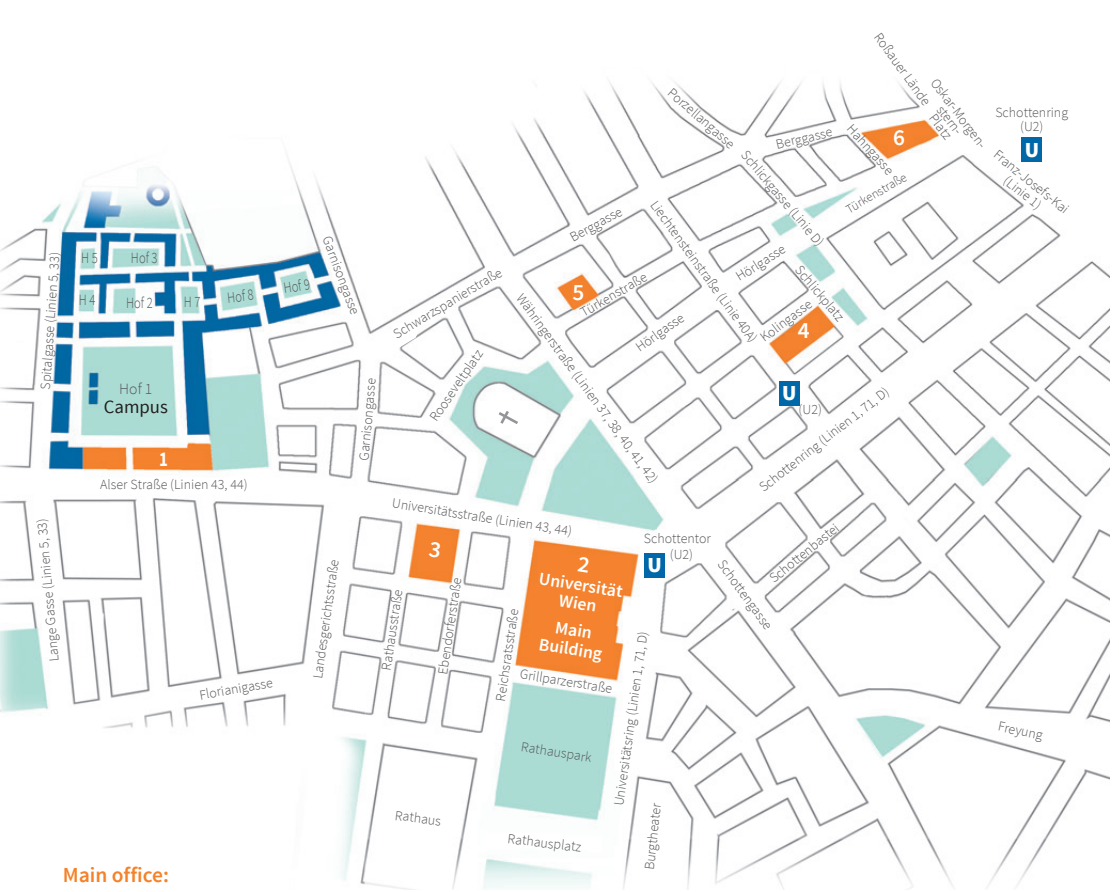
Course levels

Each CEFR-level is subdivided into two course phases (CEFR – Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

Each of our summer courses covers one phase.

In all of our courses, we offer training in the four language skills (listening, reading, writing and speaking) and also focus on grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.

A1/1 A1/2	<p>German A1: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: For participants with little or no competence in German. Reading and listening comprehension of simple texts; giving basic personal information; establishing contacts with others; taking part in simple conversations; acquiring fundamental vocabulary and learning basic grammar structures that enable elementary spoken and written communication in everyday situations.</p>
A2/1 A2/2	<p>German A2: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: Communication in familiar, everyday situations; reading and listening comprehension of the core message of texts involving topics and requirements of everyday life and familiar situations; writing elementary texts about familiar topics and personal interests.</p>
B1/1 B1/2	<p>German B1: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: Communication on general topics; verbal expression for more complex conversations; writing of basic official documents; comprehension of general content of simple radio or television broadcasts; command of basic vocabulary on general topics.</p>
B2/1 B2/2	<p>German B2: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: Further development of reading and listening strategies for enhanced comprehension of complex texts on abstract and concrete topics; boosting vocabulary for clear and adequate action and reaction in written and spoken communication on a wide spectrum of subject matters.</p>
C1/1 C1/2	<p>German C1: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: Enhancement of written and spoken instruments of communication, thus enabling effective and flexible use of the language within the realm of public/professional life and/or in education and studies. Understanding complex written and audio materials from different media, participating in discussions, drafting detailed and written statements and comments on complex topics.</p>
C2/1 C2/2	<p>German C2: <i>Phase 1 and Phase 2</i></p> <p>Objectives: Honing of written and spoken expression for spontaneous, fluent and to a large extent correct enunciation in the context of discussions and presentations. Focus on complex literary, scientific and geo-political texts (both written and audio) for enhanced comprehension and expression of fine nuances.</p>
