### **GET RICH: GOOD ROOTS**

LESSON #5

**TEACHER'S GUIDE** 

#### **LESSON OVERVIEW**

Big Idea: We need a good root system to grow big and strong

**Key Question:** What happens if our roots are bad?

**Memory Verse:** "Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong." **Ephesians 3:17** 

Overview: We're continuing in our series called "Get Rich". We're not talking about getting rich with money. We're talking about being rich in God's love. We've been looking at the book of Ephesians and some important lessons Paul teaches us about our relationship with God. We've already learned that when we trust in Jesus, we are adopted into God's family and that we need to get to know God more to realize how great he is. We've also learned about God's grace and peace. Today, we're going to learn about having good roots. Have you ever thought about how a tree grows? A tree needs good roots to drink up the water so the tree can grow. The better the roots, the bigger the tree. Did you know that's how it works for us, too? We need to have good roots to grow big and strong as a Christian. Here are 3 key roots we need: 1. Faith-a strong relationship with God 2. Family-we need family to love us, care for us and to teach us. 3. Friends-we need good friends that encourage us to honor God. If we have these roots established in our lives, we can grow up strong and understand how rich we are in God's love.

#### **TEACHER TIPS**

**2nd-5th puzzle key:** God, faith, grow, family. Message: Have good roots

A healthy plant or tree will grow when it's healthy. It needs to have good soil, lots of water and tender loving care. We need to have good roots in order to grow in God's love.

#### Answer: We'll be "sick" and unable to grow

Just like a tree, if we don't have good roots we won't be able to grow. Bad roots would mean the following: we don't care about God or his opinion, we don't want to obey our parents and we hang around with friends that want us to do bad stuff. If those are the roots in your life, you won't be able to grow strong and healthy. You'll be "sick" with disobedience, bad thoughts, a selfish heart, and be far from God...

**Bonus Questions:** What are some other examples of bad roots that could make us sick?

**4-5th**: Why do we need to be careful with the kind of friends we choose? How can our friends lead us astray?

To grow in our faith means we get to know God more. We do that by **reading the Bible** and spending time **praying** everyday. It means **going to church** and worshipping God with other Christians and **helping others**. When we understand just how great God is, and all that he's done for us, we will be very thankful. We will realize just how blessed and rich we are in God.

### Option #1

### **Grow Big and Strong Tree Craft**

- Give each kid a tree template (page 5).
- Give each kid a ½ piece of construction paper.
- Have kids glue the tree onto the construction paper.
- Have kids color the trunk and branches of the tree.
- Give kids finger paints and have them dip their fingertips into the paint and stamp their prints onto the tree branches to look like leaves. Allow them to be creative with their colors.
- Then have kids alue the saving at the base of the tree and remind them that they need faith in God, family and good friends to help them grow big and strong.

### Supplies needed

- Tree template (pg 5), pre cut, 1 set per kid
- Construction paper, cut in halves, 1 per kid
- Glue
- Crayons
- Finger paint


### Bonus Questions: Use these passages to have more conversations this week.






