## San Diego Padres (79-82) vs. San Francisco Giants (106-55)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Padres play the final game of the series and the regular season this afternoon...the Giants enter play today having won seven of their last eight and 22 of their last 28 games overall after dropping yesterday afternoon's game in 10 innings to halt their seven game winning streak.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE 411:** SF holds a one game lead over the Dodgers in the NL West entering play today after the Dodgers won last night...the Giants can secure the NL West title with a win today over San Diego or a Dodgers loss to Milwaukee...if the two teams are tied at the end of today, the Giants will host the Dodgers tomorrow in a Tiebreaker game here at Oracle Park with a time to be determined.

**GOOD VIBES ONLY:** October 3 has been a good day for Giants clinch dates in team history...the Giants clinched the 1951 pennant 70 years ago today thanks to **Bobby Thomson's** Shot Heard 'Round the World, defeating Brooklyn 5-4...they also clinched the NL pennant on this date in 1962, defeating the Dodgers 6-4 at Dodger Stadium in what was Game 165, the final game of a three-game playoff series to determine a pennant winner...in more recent Giants lore, SF clinched the NL West on this date in 2010, defeating San Diego 3-0 here at Oracle Park...**C Buster Posey** homered in that clincher for SF.

**THE PROFESSOR:** Today marks Giants 3B Coach **Ron Wotus'** final regular season game as he has announced that he is stepping away from full-time coaching following the conclusion of the season...Wotus is the longest tenured coach in Giants history as he's in his 24th year on the Major League coaching staff after beginning that run as a 3B Coach in 1998 under then manager **Dusty Baker**... Wotus has been a part of over 2,000 Giants wins since he's been a member of the Major League staff...he's been on the Major League staff's of the aforementioned Baker, **Felipe Alou**, **Bruce Bochy** and **Gabe Kapler**...overall, the 2021 season marks Wotus' 34th year in the Giants organization after he entered the organization as a player at the end of his career in 1988

**BE A GOLDFISH:** The Giants have been MLB's best team this season when following a loss, posting a .685 winning percentage (37-17) in such games...the last time the Giants lost consecutive games were to these Padres here at Oracle Park September 15-16.

**CLIMBING EVEREST:** SF's 106 wins this season match the 1904 NY Giants for most in franchise history...this is the eighth season in which a Giants team has won at least 100 games in a season...the last National League teams to win at least 106 games were the 2019 Dodgers and the 1998 Braves...the last NL team to win more than 106 were the 1986 Mets, who won 108...overall, the Giants are the 10th National League team in history to win at least 106 games.

**BELIEVE IT:** SF's 106 victories this year are a new Major League record for most wins in a season after finishing below .500 the season before...additionally, the Giants are looking at one of the biggest turnarounds in franchise history as well...SF's .174 winning percentage improvement between two seasons is currently tied for fourth-best in franchise history.

**124 DAYS AND COUNTING...:** The Giants have held the best overall record in MLB this year for 124 days...the Dodgers are second on this list (19 days).

**BUCK THE TREND:** A win today would give the Giants their first win in their regular season finale since 2017 when they won on a walk off home run from **Pablo Sandoval** in the bottom of the 9th inning off San Diego's Phil Maton.

### THOSE BOARDS DON'T WORK ON WATER, UNLESS YOU'VE GOT POWER:

As noted on the right, 49.9 percent of the Giants runs this season (396/793) have come via the home run...that's the highest total in franchise history, comfortably ahead of last season's 44.1% mark in the short season...also of note, **Austin Slater's** go-ahead, pinch-hit HR yesterday was the 111th homer that's given SF a lead or tied a game which is most in the Majors...the Atlanta Braves are second with 101...percentage-wise, 46.3 percent of the Giants homers this year have given them a lead or tied the game (111-of-240).

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

**RHP Reiss Knehr** starts for San Diego, making his 12th Major League appearance and fifth start...Knehr, who made his Major League debut in early July vs. Colorado, last worked in relief on September 28 at the Dodgers, allowing one hit in 2.0 scoreless innings with three walks and three strikeouts...in his four starts this season, he's 0-1 with a 6.57 ERA (9er, 12.1ip)...today's outing will be his first career appearance against the Giants.

**RHP Logan Webb** gets the ball in the Giants final regular season game...Webb allowed one unearned run on four hits over 5.0 innings in his last start vs. Arizona on Tuesday here at Oracle in SF's 6-4 win...in two starts this year vs. San Diego, Webb is 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7er, 10.0ip)...Oracle Park has been a kind place to Webb in 2021 as the righty has gone 5-0 with a 1.63 ERA in the home confines this season...SF has not lost any of his 11 home starts this season.

## GIANTS HOME RUNS

The Giants enter today with 240 homers, second-most in the Majors behind Toronto (258)...SF has scored 49.9% of their runs off home runs (396 of 793 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 240 homers are the most in franchise history.

**TODAY'S OUTING:** Logan Webb will take the mound for his 26th start of the season today as the Giants host the Padres... the right-hander is 10-3 with a 2.93 ERA (46er, 141.1ip) in 26 games (25 starts) in his third season with SF...the Giants are 20-5 in his starts this year, winning 17 of his last 19 outings.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision after holding Arizona hitters to a one unearned run on four hits over 5.0 innings last Tuesday here at home...struck out six of the 20 batters he faced and walked two...the outing marked his sixth start this season without allowing an earned run.

**VS. SAN DIEGO:** Is slated to face the Padres for a sixth time in his career and third this season...is 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (9er, 20.0ip) in five appearances (four starts) vs. the Friars...Webb has not faced the Padres at home since last season and has a 1.50 ERA (1er, 6.0ip) with seven strikeouts in two appearances against them here at Oracle Park...last faced San Diego on September 23 at Petco Park, when he threw just 4.0 innings and allowed four runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts.

**ELITE STRETCH:** Webb has gone 9-0 with a 2.22 ERA (27er, 109.1ip) and .217 opposing average over his last 19 starts...he has struck out 117 batters and held opponents to six homers (0.49 HR/9ip) in that stretch...the outings helped him lower his ERA from the 5.34 figure he had through his first seven starts of the season to his current 2.93 mark...his 2.22 ERA since May 11 is lowest in MLB (min. 15gs).

**CUTTING YOUR LOSSES:** The stretch also marks 19 consecutive starts without a losing decision, something no Giants pitcher can claim since Mike Krukow did so from 1997-1988...the streak is tied for fourth-longest in Giants history (see above chart on the right)...SF is 17-2 as a team in his last 19 starts.

**UNDEFEATED TERRITORY:** Webb is 5-0 with a 1.63 ERA (12er, 66.1ip) in 11 games at Oracle Park this season...his 1.66 ERA at home is second-lowest in the Majors (min. 65.0ip), trailing only PHI's Ranger Suarez (1.51)...SF has won each of his 11 home starts this year, the most consecutive team wins in a Giant player's home starts to begin a season since Billy Pierce led the Giants to win 12 straight in 1962...the last team to go undefeated at home when a player starts was Zack Greinke's Brewers in 2011 (Stats, LLC).

## DICK TIDROW 1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children—Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
