HISTORY OF GLADEWATER FORMER STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION

The very first recorded meeting for GFSA was January 17, 1987. It was attended by 40 former students through the efforts of Frank Hathorn, Lee Fisher Betty Pippin, Nauty Byrd Mayer, James Clark, Truman Wilson, David Moore, Frances Foshee Beavers, June Strawn Gelvin, Beth Beard Graham, Ernestine Wilson Sawyer, Helen Adams Thomas, Frances Waggoner and many others. On Friday, September 23, 1988, the first All-School Reunion, honoring the Class of 1938 on their 50th anniversary, was held at the Gladewater High School cafeteria with over 400 in attendance.

Before GFSA had its own building, the group met at Club Lake and at a downtown restaurant. Dorothy Dake and Tom Anderson donated the GFSA building to the organization.

The ground-breaking of the GFSA building took place on March 26, 1994. It was a cold and rainy day, but still was attended by more than 30 brave and faithful supporters. In spite of the weather, the group had a fabulous time anticipating the birth of the GFSA home. President Sherry Beall presided over the ground-breaking ceremonies. Reverend Clayton Gilpin of the First Methodist Church opened the ceremonies with prayer and Wanda Marlowe led the singing of The National Anthem and the GHS Alma Mater. A brief history of the group's endeavors was given by President Beall. Dorothy Dake Anderson and her husband, Tom, addressed the attendees explaining that they had donated the building for the future happiness and use to the Gladewater Exes. GFSA will be eternally grateful for their generosity.

A dedication and ribbon-cutting ceremony took place on August 13, 1994, hosted by Dorothy and Tom Anderson. Over 200 former students were in attendance. Others that were specifically recognized at this celebration were Dr. Sally Lancaster, the Meadows Foundation, Bobbi Milliorn and Charles Modisette, John Paul Tallent and Bob Dooley (Builders) and Mayor Jackie Wood.
