




Girls Softball

After a long flight delay from Midway Airport on Saturday, March 23, the Titans hurriedly made it to Poway High School in time to post a 13-12 win.




Over the weekend, the Titans beat Providence (IN) 3-0. Ryan O'Hara and Declan Hood combine to give up 1 hit and face the minimum.

Sailing Club


The GBS Sailing Team begins its Spring racing season in April!


