As I read and reflect on the Christmas story from Luke's Gospel, a phrase caught my attention. Luke 2:7 reads,

"And Mary gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in bands of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn."

"There was no place for them..." I wonder how many people at the time of Jesus' birth felt like there wasn't a place for them, either? "There was no place for them" politically, economically, religiously or socially. That, in and of itself, can feel like isolation. They have no place to go.

I am sure we all have moments where we feel we have "no place" to go or where we feel we do not fit in or belong. It can, at times, feel like we are isolated or we exist in a dark and lonely night.

There was even room for hope! It was the miracle of this first Christmas when heaven and earth touched and kissed that the "vacancy sign" was lit for all eternity. Now everyone in the world would know that there is room for all in God's house and family.

This same hope still exists today. Yes, even more than 2,000 years later, the light of heaven still shines brightly in all the dark corners of our lives and reminds us that we belong, we matter, and there is room for us.

Please join us either in person or virtually for worship on Christmas Eve to celebrate the Baby's cry still being heard and the "vacancy sign" being on. There is hope for all of us for all eternity.

May you and your family have a blessed and joy-filled Christmas with the shining hope of the Christ Child!
