MBF's Commissioner Willy Gort Scholarship Program Criteria

ADMINISTRATION OF THE PROGRAM

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be:

2. United States citizens or permanent residents.
3. Planning to attend or attending George T. Baker Technical College, Lindsey Hopkins Technical College, or Miami Dade College. Programs covered at these schools are listed in addendum.
4. All applicants must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) unless enrolling in a certificate program below 450 hours that do not qualify for Financial Aid and the Federal Pell Grant and/or applicants without High School Diploma or GED.

Addendum 2

Federal Student Aid

To be eligible for MBF's Commissioner Willy Gort Scholarship, the student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Federal student aid coverage covers one full academic year. The 2016-2017 federal student aid covers the Fall 2016, Spring 2017, and Summer 2017 trimesters. If the student wishes to start a program in the summer, they must complete the FAFSA of the previous academic year.

The FAFSA can be completed at www.fafsa.gov. Students must complete the FAFSA every academic year. Students must communicate with their schools to obtain the FAFSA deadlines.

To be eligible to receive federal student aid, you must:

- Be a citizen or eligible noncitizen of the United States.
- Have a valid Social Security Number.
- Have a high school diploma or a General Education Development (GED) certificate, or have completed homeschooling. If you do not, you may still be eligible for federal student aid if you were enrolled in college or career school prior to July 1, 2012.*
- Be enrolled in an eligible program as a regular student seeking a degree or certificate.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- Not owe a refund on a federal student grant or be in default on a federal student loan.
- Register (or already be registered) with the Selective Service System, if you are a male and not currently on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces.
- Not have a conviction for the possession or sale of illegal drugs for an offense that occurred while you were receiving federal student aid (such as grants, work-study, or loans). If you have such a conviction, you must complete the Student Aid Eligibility Worksheet to determine if you are eligible for aid or partially eligible for aid.

* The MBF's Commissioner Willy Gort Scholarship program covers the cost of certificate programs, listed on Addendum 3, that do not require a High School Diploma or GED certificate. However, the student must complete the FAFSA in order to be eligible for the scholarship.

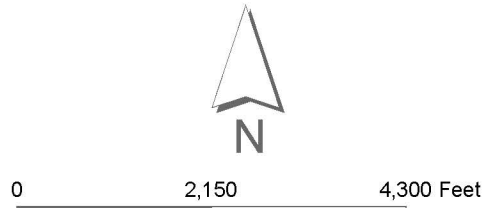
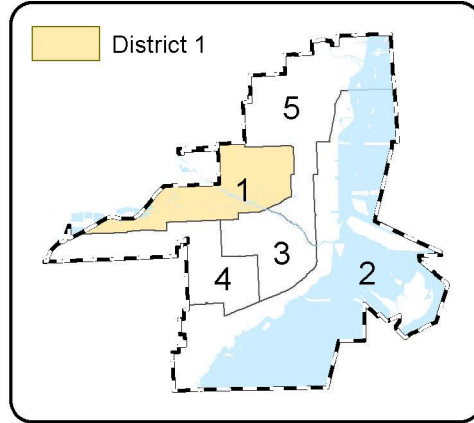
