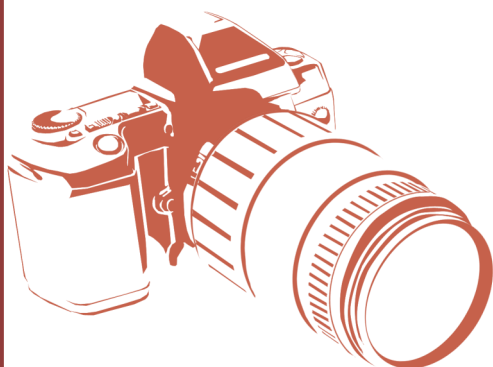
Woolworths Earn and Learn is coming back to your local store in 2019 starting on the 1<sup>st</sup> May.
