We do encourage students to keep working and keep their dreams alive.


It will not get easier at the next level.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS SIMPLIFIED

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION IS LARGELY **BASED ON GPA** NOT DATE OF APPLICATION.

There are a few key dates on the following slides.

There is no real advantage to applying to a lot of schools. Narrow down the list to legitimate options but always have a backup or two.

To apply students need to enter demographic information and pay a fee. Students do not need in-progress grade 12 marks to apply.

They also need to know their intended **faculty or major**. This can be tricky. Schools offer sites to help with this process.

Students are not locked into a faculty for life.

It is very normal for students to switch their majors. (70%) Why\$\$\$\$\$

A FEW IMPORTANT DATES TO CONSIDER WITH RESPECT TO THE APPLICATION PROCESS!

UBC EARLY ADMISSION DEADLINE: December 1st Very Competitive

This is the deadline for high achieving students want to be considered for Major scholarships and Early Admission.



UNIVERSITY

Applying to UBC involves writing a *Personal Profile. It is more involved than the traditional application. You cannot do this in one night.*

If you do not get in during the first round of admissions, your application is still active but you may not find out your status until mid-March.

UBC's REGULAR FINAL APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 15TH

SFU's APPLICATION SITE October 1st (opens)- January 31st

December 15, 2020 Undergraduate Scholars Entrance Scholarship application

for the Fall term (Sept 2021) Competitive

January 31, 2021 Final deadline to apply for everyone else.

April 30, 2021 Application and documents for all other entrance financial aid

University of Toronto Final Deadline January 15, 2021



BCIT bound students can apply at any time, if they know what they want to do. during the year. The earlier the better as it helps with waiting lists.

Local colleges have deadlines that extend into the new year. An earlier application date can impact course selection date.

Canadian schools located **outside BC** have application dates that go from md-December on. For Ontario schools it is advantageous to apply by January 15th,

US Schools Students should apply early (by mid January at the latest) They must be prepared to write their SAT's

DO YOUR OWN RESEARCH!

MARKS AND TRANSCRIPTS

GRADS WILL RECEIVE MARKS ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS OVER THE YEAR.

Early December: First Report Card


<u>Late January:</u> A special report for grade 12's only. It is timed to coincide with scholarship and admission deadlines with

eastern schools

Mid-March: This is the most important set of marks. They confirm admission and awarding of scholarships.

IMPORTANT STEP FOR ALL GRADS OF 2021! THEY MUST RELEASE THEIR MARKS. YOU CAN HELP!

STUDENTS <u>MUST CREATE</u> AN ACCOUNT ON THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION SITE WHICH ALLOWS POST SECONDARY SCHOOLS TO ACCESS THEIR OFFICIAL MARKS. STUDENT WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THIS TASK WILL RECEIVE AN EMAIL THAT LOOKS LIKE THIS. CHECK TO MAKE SURE YOUR SON OR DAUGHTER HAS RECEIVED THIS!



\$CHOLARSHIP\$

Typically the scholarships awarded in the fall are very competitive, but as the year unfolds numerous smaller scholarships become available. There is no magic list.

Students have been encouraged to register on scholarship search sites like YCONIC (https://scholartree.ca/ These are reputable sites that make students aware of upcoming deadlines throughout the year.

Other sources to search

athletic, cultural or religious clubs that students are affiliated with parents' places of work
financial institutions

Through the CLC blocks we will also have students do the preparation work required to apply for scholarships. We have also posted a list of External Scholarships that are awarded every year.

The list of STMC scholarships will be made official in the new year and all will have a deadline of early May or so.





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
