As a highly respected community leader with vision, strong principles and passion, Dr YU has selflessly devoted a tremendous amount of time and resources to public service and strived for the prosperity, harmony and stability of Hong Kong as a whole.

Mr HO Tsu-kwok, Charles

Mr HO is awarded the GBM in recognition of his distinguished service to the community, particularly his contribution to the media industry. As the Chairman of a renowned media corporation, Mr HO has successfully led his group in providing readers, including the global Chinese communities, with comprehensive and timely news and information through its extensive media network and multi-media platform over the years. Mr HO has also exhibited extensive generosity and continued with the philanthropic tradition of his family in supporting a wide range of community and charitable activities.

Gold Bauhinia Star (GBS)

The Honourable Mr Justice Frank STOCK, JP

Mr Justice STOCK is awarded the GBS in recognition of his dedicated and distinguished service in the Judiciary, particularly his significant contribution as the Judge in charge of the Constitutional and Administrative Law List in the High Court, and in handling criminal appeal cases in the Court of Appeal as well as his devotion in the development of legal education. Mr Justice STOCK retired as the Vice President of the Court of Appeal after serving over 36 years with the Government and the Judiciary. He is currently a Non-Permanent Judge of the Court of Final Appeal in the Judiciary.

Mr CHAK Hoi-leung, MBS

Mr CHAK, an Air Crewman Officer III, is awarded the MBS in recognition of his act of gallantry of an extremely high order displayed in an off-shore search and rescue operation to save the crew of a disabled vessel “Trans Summer” during Typhoon Utor on 14 August 2013. Being the winchman of the second rescue helicopter, he was lowered to the loaded lift raft to pick up the survivors under severe weather conditions and a hostile operating environment. He had been fighting against the waves and wind for almost one hour and successfully saved 15 lives. He displayed tremendous courage, selflessness, commitment to duty and professionalism of the highest order.

Mr YUEN Ka-wai

Mr YUEN, an Air Crewman Officer III, is awarded the MBS in recognition of his act of gallantry of an extremely high order displayed in an off-shore search and rescue operation to save the crew of a disabled vessel “Trans Summer” during Typhoon Utor on 14 August 2013. Being the winchman of the first rescue helicopter, he was lowered to the rough sea under the severe weather conditions without hesitation. He exposed himself to extreme physical danger in a very hostile environment, showing an extraordinary act of heroism and professionalism and successfully saved four lives. He displayed courage, selflessness and professionalism of the highest order.
