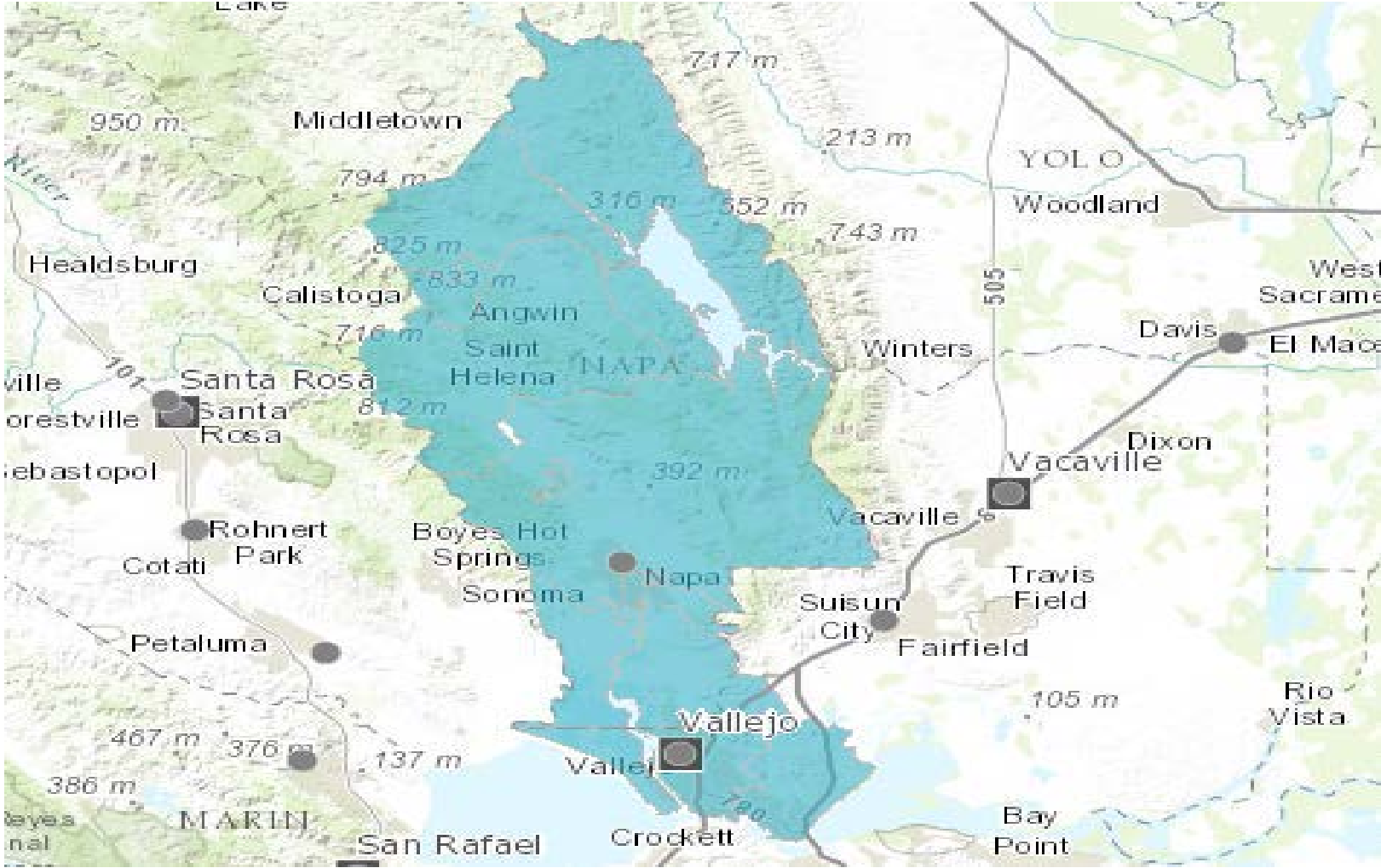
Kaiser Permanente's mission is to provide high-quality, affordable health care services and to ***improve the health of*** our members and ***the communities we serve.***

## Access to Care and Coverage

Strategies	Outcomes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Support outreach, enrollment, retention and appropriate utilization of health care coverage programs.</li><li>• Improve navigation to obtain access to appropriate care within the health care system.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase in the number of low-income patients that enroll in health care coverage programs.</li><li>• Increase in the number of low-income patients who receive health care services/coverage.</li></ul>

# Kaiser Permanente in the Community: 2017-2019 Health Funding Priorities



## Behavioral Health

Strategies	Outcomes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provide screening and identification related to behavioral health needs among low income, vulnerable and uninsured populations and connect them with the appropriate services or support.</li><li>• Increase the capacity to respond appropriately to individuals and/or communities that have experienced trauma and/or violence.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase screening for behavioral health needs.</li><li>• Increase access to appropriate services and support for behavioral health needs.</li><li>• Increase organizational capacity to offer quality services to individuals and communities experiencing trauma/violence.</li></ul>



## Community & Family Safety

Strategies	Outcomes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase availability of education, job training and enrichment programs for youth.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase enrollment and completion of education and job training programs for youth.</li></ul>



## Healthy Eating Active Living

Strategies	Outcomes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase access to healthy, affordable foods, including fresh produce, and decrease access to unhealthy food.</li><li>• Increase access to physical activity opportunities in the community.</li><li>• Increase access to physical activity opportunities in schools.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increased consumption of fruits and vegetables.</li><li>• Increased physical activity.</li></ul>

- List school(s) potentially interested in the program
- Include free & reduced price meal participation percentages for each school
