Great is Thy faithfulness, Lord, unto me!

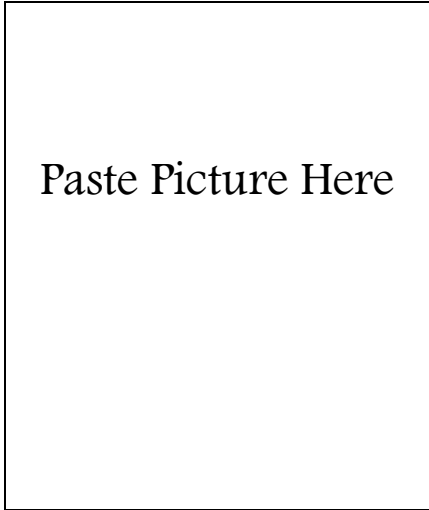
Summer and winter and springtime and harvest,
