

If I had committed the five Avici misdeeds, or instructed others to commit them, or rejoice upon seeing them being committed;

If I had committed the ten non virtuous deeds, or instructed others to commit them, or rejoice upon seeing them being committed;

Of all these misdeeds, whether concealed or exposed.

Such misdeeds should have caused rebirth in hells or rebirth as a hungry ghost or an animal or rebirth in places of sufferings or wilderness, or born with a lowly status or born as a heretic or in such similar places and situations.

All these offences and transgression, and all the obstacles, calamities and misfortunes that follow as a results, I now remorsefully repent everything and wish for their elimination and absolution.

Today, may all Bhagavan Buddha(s), take heed of me, know me and remember me. Now, in front of all these Buddha(s), I declare as follow If I have done any <u>charity</u> or <u>observe any precept properly</u> in this life or in my countless rebirths, even if it is just feeding an animal a small morsel of food.

or perhaps if I practice any cultivation purely, then all virtuous root causes arising thus:

or perhaps if I help beings with their accomplishment, then all virtuous root causes arising thus;

or perhaps if I practice the path towards Enlightenment, then all virtuous root causes arising thus,

or perhaps if I practice the cultivation of ultimate wisdom, then all virtuous root causes arising thus,

All these virtuous root causes, accumulated together, reckoned and measured,

I hereby dedicate towards Annutara Samyaksambodhi

Similar to the dedication made by past, present and future Buddha(s), Likewise I follow their example and dedicate accordingly too. I repent all misdeeds and share all blessings
May I attain the merits and virtues of Buddha(s)
May I attain supreme wisdom too.

The past, present and future Buddha(s) are peerless amongst beings I take refuge with my life in Buddha(s) who possess oceans of infinite merits and virtues.

To the lion amongst man, in all the worlds throughout the ten directions and in all three times. I pay homage to all of them without any exceptions with my pure action, speech and thought.

Through the magnificent spiritual power of Samantabadhra, I manifest in the presence of all Tathagata(s)

Transforming my body into myriad bodies as many as the dust in all worlds, we pay homage to Buddha(s) as numerous as all myriad dust in existence.

In each mote of dust are myriad Buddha(s) as limitless as motes of dust in existence and each one of them dwelling in an assemblies of Bodhisattvas

This is the same throughout the infinite motes of dust in the infinite Dharma Realms. I firmly believe that Buddha(s) completely resides in all of them

Each of my myriad manifestations uses myriad pleasant sounds to express myriad wonderful words and phrases to praise the ocean deep merits and virtues of all Buddha(s) until the end of time.

Using the best and wondrous flower garlands, music, perfumes, parasols and canopies, the best decorations and ornaments that are rich and rare, we make offerings to all the Tathagata(s).

The best clothing and best incense, powdered incense and lit incense, lamps and candle light. All these offerings heaped as high as a great mountain, I hereby offer them to all Tathagata(s)

Based on a mind that is vast and open, capable of understanding the most extraordinary, I firmly believe in all the Buddha(s) throughout the three period of time.

Based on the power of Samantabadra's conduct and vows, I make offerings to all Tathagata(s) who reside everywhere.

I hereby repent all my past misdeeds caused by craving, aversion and ignorance and created through my actions, speech and thoughts,

I rejoice in the virtues and merits of all sentient beings, the Sravakas and Pratyeka Buddhas, all types of practitioners of the Hinayana and Mahayana path, as well as all Buddha(s) and Bodhisattvas.

Lights of the worlds in the ten directions and those who were the first to attain Bodhi, I hereby entreat them to turn the unsurpassable Dharma Wheel.

If any Buddha intends to manifest Parinirvana, I shall earnestly entreat them to remain till the end of time to benefit and delight all sentient beings.

I dedicate all the blessings and merits arising from paying homage, praising and making offerings to Buddha(s),

entreating Buddha(s) to remain in worldly existence to teach the dharma, as well as merits arising from rejoicing and repentance, towards the complete Enlightenment of all sentient beings.

May all these excellent merits and virtues be dedicated throughout the supreme Dharma Realm.
