


Most other vessels have 4 or 5 passengers for each crew member. The extra crew allows for an outstanding level of service, care and attention, which is the hallmark of the Peter Deilmann brand. It is also nice to know that, unlike most other river cruises, there is a certified medical doctor on-board every voyage.

Shore Excursions

Excursions ashore are coordinated right from the ship, hosted by local English-speaking guides in each place along the route. Several excursions are included in the fare of our cruise-tour vacations, which can be found throughout the brochure. For those not participating in an inclusive cruisetour, you can book optional shore excursions on the vessel at an additional cost. A money-saving package of shore excursions is available for pre-purchase on almost every itinerary. By not including excursions in the cruise-only fare, you pay for only those you choose to take.

Your Floating Resort

Regardless of which vessel in the fleet you choose, your stateroom will allow you to luxuriate with special touches like European duvets and feather pillows (or synthetic if you prefer). Bathrobes and hair dryers are always available upon request. Plus, our recently instituted non-smoking policy allows smoking only on deck. The MV Mozart is known for the most splendid accommodations on the rivers, with standard staterooms of 203 square feet and suites of 406 square feet. Our MV Heidelberg has staterooms that are 190 square feet. MV Mozart, MV Katharina von Bora, MV Casanova, MV Frederic Chopin, MV Heidelberg and MV Cézanne all offer a choice of queen-bedded cabins in addition to the usual twins. MV Princesse de Provence, MV Katharina von Bora, MV Heidelberg, MV Casanova and MV Frederic Chopin all sport upper-deck staterooms with full-length opening French doors instead of windows. The MV Heidelberg cabins on the middle deck also have French doors. This allows a sensuous experience where you can savor the air of the lush countryside while still in your robe. The MV Mozart has the only full-size indoor pool and solarium to be found on the rivers of Europe.

No-Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all our guests, Peter Deilmann Cruises has expanded the no-smoking restrictions on its European river fleet to include all areas inside the vessels without exception. Smoking will be permitted only on the open decks.



Highlights Along the Danube All the Way to the Black Sea

Belgrade, Serbia

Marvel at the sight of the Kalemegdan Fortress, where you will find a lovely park with ancient Roman and Turkish ruins. Discover the Saint George Orthodox Church decorated with numerous mosaics. Visit the Arandjelovac health resort before strolling through the beautiful spa gardens and the outdoor museum where more than 100 white marble statues are exhibited. The Skadarlija Bohemian quarter offers many delights including antique shops and more.

Bratislava, Slovakia

Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, is located at the foot of the Little Carpathian Mountains on the banks of the Danube River. A highlight of the city tour is Primate's Palace with its remarkable gallery of famous European artists. Visit the Slovak National Museum and the Slovak National Gallery with their historical treasures. Explore the majestic Bratislava Castle built above the Danube. It was a frontier post of the Roman Empire from the 1st to the 5th centuries.

Budapest, Hungary

Among the most beautiful cities in Europe, Budapest graces the banks of the Danube River for nearly 8 miles. With her elegant Parliament Building and eight bridges, entering Budapest is the most breathtaking sight of all the rivers in Europe. The city tour introduces you to many of her treasures including Hero's Square, the Parliament and Castle Mount.

Dürnstein, Austria

Dürnstein lies in the heart of the beautiful Wachau wine region.

See Kuenringer Castle overlooking this enchanting town. "Richard the Lionhearted" was reputedly held prisoner there. Stroll past many well-kept 16th-century burgher houses as well as the 14th-century Klarissin Convent. During a walking tour, visit Collegiate Church and sample delicious local wines in a tavern.

Esztergom, Hungary

Marvel at the largest church in Hungary modeled on St. Peters in Rome, and visit the remains of the former Royal Palace. At Szentendre on the Danube Bend, visit the wonderful Margit Kovacs Ceramic Museum and the interesting Greek Orthodox church.

Galați, Romania

Visit the beautiful 15th-century Eastern Orthodox Cathedral of St. George. You might take a stroll along a sculpture park or visit a botanical garden and newly-restored Opera House. A television tower open to the public offers spectacular views of the city.

Giurgiu, Romania

While visiting this charming town, stop by the impressive Giurgiu town hall. Stroll through the quaint shops as you enjoy a walking tour. Visit the historic town walls and medieval fortress ruins, and marvel at the clock tower.

Grein, Austria

This charming Gothic village offers a picturesque setting on the banks of the Danube. Visit the historic town theater, which is the oldest in Central Europe. Stroll to the city square surrounded by the town hall and the church. Explore Castle Greinburg, built

in the Renaissance style with an arcade courtyard.

Iron Gate Gorge

This narrow gorge separating Romania and Serbia offers some of the most breathtaking natural scenery on the Danube. Gliding between the Balkan and Carpathian Mountains, you'll see where the Roman Emperor Trajan's bridge once spanned the Danube nearly 2,000 years ago.

Linz, Austria

Explore Sankt/Saint Martins church, the oldest Austrian church. Discover the fabulous Lentos Art Museum and Brucknerhaus Concert Hall. See the very interesting Ars Electronica Center, home to one of the few public 3D Cave Automatic Virtual Environments in Europe.

Melk, Austria

One of the most splendid examples of Baroque architecture in Europe, the magnificent Benedictine Abbey in Melk dominates the city high above the Danube River. Admire the famous Melk Cross, the Abbey Library and sweeping views of the river valley.

Mohacs, Hungary

Delight in the scenic wonder of this southern town on the



Danube. Marvel at the Djami protestant church with its distinct green copper roof at the Szechenyi Square. Explore the craft shops and possibly sample the Forralt bor, a hot and tasty white wine that is a favorite of the local people.

Oltenita, Romania

Discover the scenic beauty of this mountainous region. Filled with lush woods and fields of grain, this picturesque town along the Danube will certainly please the senses.

Orsova, Romania

Wander through the wonderful oak forests that surround this lovely town. Also, enjoy the

panoramic view of Saint Ana Monastery.

Passau, Germany

This picturesque city is ideally located at the confluence of the Inn, Ilz and Danube Rivers just a short distance from Germany's border with Austria. Visit the wonderful old town and discover the impressive St. Stephen's Cathedral with its lavish interior and the world's second largest pipe organ. The cathedral is the largest Baroque church north of the Alps.

Ruse, Bulgaria

Ruse was once the garrison of the Roman Danube fleet. Explore the Pantheon, the Alyosha Monument and the concert hall as well as the Liberty Monument and the Opera House. Experience local cuisine accompanied by folk music.

Tulcea, Romania

Noted as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the waters of the Danube flow to the Black Sea to form the Danube Delta Region. This is Europe's largest and best preserved delta region, hosting more than 300 species of birds and 45 species of freshwater fish in its numerous lakes and marshes. Marvel at the magnificent monastery with its Turkish-style influence.

Turnu Severin, Romania

Turnu Severin dates back to 100 AD when it served as a base for Roman Emperor Trajan and his campaigns into Northern Europe. The city tour takes you to the bridge of Apollodorus of Damascus, the Roman fortress Castrum and the city's archeological museum.

Vienna, Austria

The historic center of Vienna is rich in architecture, including Baroque castles and gardens, grand buildings, monuments and parks. It has been recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore this beautiful city of waltzes, cafés, classical music, parks, pastries and wine. Marvel at the majesty of St. Stephan's Cathedral, crowned with a 450-foot steeple. Discover its wonderful stone canopies, intricate altarpieces and Gothic sculptures; then climb the spiral steps of the tower for a magnificent view of the city. Vienna is also home of the famous Vienna Boys Choir. The nearby Schönbrunn Palace and Gardens with its outstanding examples of decorative art. It was the residence of the Habsburg emperors from the 18th and 19th centuries, and it is noted as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
