
The Greater Derry-Salem Transit Coordination Region



The Greater Derry-Salem Regional Coordinating Council for Community Transportation (RCC) is a partnership of the Greater Derry-Salem CART transit system, the Rockingham Planning Commission, Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission, the region's ten towns, multiple non-profit human service agencies, and non-profit and for profit transportation providers.

The role of the RCC is to help expand, coordinate and improve transportation options within the Greater Derry-Salem region so that seniors, individuals with disabilities, low income residents and others can get where they need to go and live with independence and dignity. The work of the RCC is also designed to help municipalities, human service agencies and other organizations purchase shared ride coordinated transportation services for their citizens, clients, and customers.

Towns included in the region include Atkinson, Chester, Danville, Derry, Hampstead, Londonderry, Plaistow, Salem, Sandown and Windham.

This directory lists a variety of services, including intercity bus, public transportation, non-profit agency van services, volunteer driver programs and for-profit wheelchair van companies.

Medicaid Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

Need a ride to a medical appointment?

If you receive Medicaid benefits through New Hampshire Healthy Families or Well Sense, be aware that transportation to non-emergency medical appointments is a covered benefit available at no cost to you.

How does non-emergency medical transportation work?

Both New Hampshire Healthy Families and Well Sense contract with Coordinated Transportation Solutions (CTS) to manage non-emergency transportation services. To arrange a ride, call the CTS Member Line toll free at **855-739-4775**. CTS can arrange to do one of the following:

- Pay you for mileage from your home to your healthcare service and back if you have circumstances that prevent you from being able to afford the cost of transportation
- Pay your friends or family for mileage costs to take you from your home to your healthcare service and back
- Pay you to use public transportation to get you to your healthcare service and back
- Arrange for a taxi to drive you to and from your healthcare service
- Arrange for a specialty vehicle when needed, such as a wheelchair van or ambulance, to drive you to and from your visit
