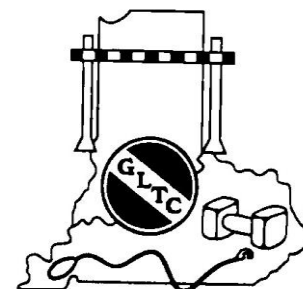

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

SHOW HOURS each day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEPHONE, EMAILED, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official

AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. Unsigned entries or entries missing information will be returned.**

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted. Entry fees: \$20.00 first entry, \$18 for each additional entry of the same dog on the same day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for first entry and \$3.00 entry for every additional run)

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed

(IF YOUR DOG HAS AN AKC NUMBER (not ILP, PAL or Canine Partners number) YOU KNOW YOUR BREEDER, SIRE & DAM AND IT NEEDS TO BE INCLUDED ON THE ENTRY FORMIT IS REQUIRED!!! Chapter 1 Section 11 if you don't believe me!)

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

Greater Louisville Training Club, Inc., its agents etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries due to bitches which come in season after trial has closed and for dogs injured prior to March 17 upon written certification by a Veterinarian minus a \$5 per class fee. *An injury is any wound or damage to the body resulting from physical activity. Some common injury types are: cut, abrasion, fracture and burn. Sprain and strain injuries to muscles, joints and connective tissues are classified as injuries.* Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary **no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial (March 12th).**

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing.** (E-Mail is acceptable.) All move-ups for the weekend must be received by the trial secretary no later than Monday, March 15, 2021 at **6PM.** Day to day move-ups will be accepted over the weekend. No moving down or changing or height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive or blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches or under at the withers.

24 CHOICE

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. **FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.**

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

(Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

I, _____, am aware of the potential spread of COVID-19 that could result in severe illness and potential death. My presence at these agility trials proves I voluntarily accept this risk and accept sole responsibility for any injury (including, but not limited to, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind) that may be experienced or incurred in connection with attendance at these agility trials.

I understand the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at these agility trials held at Silver Street Park, March 18-21, 2021, may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, The Greater Louisville Training Club, Inc. show staff, employees, volunteers, participants, attendees, and their families. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold The Greater Louisville Training, Inc., Silver Street Park, its agents, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, attendees, or other participants from any claim.

Social Distancing:

- I will, to the best of my ability, practice proper social distancing as recommended by the State of Indiana, "Back on Track" directives, as well as practicing good hygiene (hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, wearing a mask at all times when in the building except when running my dogs (mask may be taken off in the ring and placed in your pocket, then put back on before exiting the ring) and when around other people on the grounds) and follow any other health recommendations.
- I will not sit in groups closer than 6 feet and will practice social distancing in holding areas, while walking the course, in the parking lot, and on the show site. Crating areas will be taped out, and you must stay within your space. All chairs will be in the spot marked for your chair to maintain the 6 ft distancing. No chairs at ringside.
- I agree to have my temperature taken before I enter the premises at Silver Street Park. I also agree to have my temperature taken at any time during the show weekend.

Health Reporting:

- I have not experienced any symptoms of possible COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a temperature greater than 100°. I have not had close contact with a person symptomatic or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. If I have been infected by COVID-19 at any time, I have been medically released to return to normal activities. If I develop a fever and symptoms, such as a cough or difficulty in breathing, or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of this event, I will report this information to The Greater Louisville Training, Inc.
- Should symptoms develop during the event, I will report symptoms to the trial chair and trial secretary and immediately leave the trial.

Other changes due to COVID-19:

- Only exhibitors will be allowed at the trial during the pandemic. No family members unless the exhibitor is a junior handler, who may have 1 (one) parent in attendance with them.
- This site has many areas where you can walk or play with your dogs and maintain social distancing. Please consider this as an option to staying in the building unless you are working. Please do not stand around the FAST Cat area unless you are competing.

- As stated, face masks must be worn when in the building and when near other people outside. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own masks. They will not be supplied by the club or Silver Street Park.
- Course maps will be posted for you to take a picture of, there will be no paper course maps at this trial. Please social distance while taking pictures of the maps.
- Due to the pandemic, there will NOT be food at this trial. We encourage you to pack a lunch. Due to the rise in numbers, we ask that you enjoy your lunch in your car. PLEASE No MACH/PACH CAKES OR SHARED FOODS OR SNACKS.
- Walk throughs will be limited to 25 exhibitors, and you must wear your mask and maintain social distancing.
- Handlers may put their leash in their pocket or wear it during their run, there will be a leash runner for those wishing to drop the leash at the start line. The leash runner will use a grabber that is dipped in disinfectant between each leash.
- There are sinks in the building, and we will have a table with sanitizer next to the ring and ribbon area. Please wash your hands often throughout the day.
- No self-serve ribbons, a member will be putting the sticker on ribbons and the results will be posted on the overhead door for you to see.
- Each person will check themselves in with your own pen, BEFORE walking the course.
- If you are not feeling well, PLEASE stay home. Contact June Ebert, our trial secretary, and you will be given a refund (minus AKC & Judges Fees) for each day you are absent. People running a fever, or visibly sick will be asked to leave with no refund.

COVID-19 has changed the way we do things in life, and agility trials are no exception to this. We ask that if you are entering GLTC's trial that you are comfortable with our guidelines and are willing to comply with all rules. Exhibitors not in compliance with these guidelines will be excused from the trial without a refund.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
