- All participants are expected to participate in at least two weekend tournaments. These tournaments are the Wood Bat tournament and the end of the season League tournament. If the team chooses to participate in additional weekend tournaments, registration fee's would be covered by the parents. These tournaments would be optional
- All participants will go through a tryout process to determine appropriate team placement.
- Try out dates will be March. More information to follow
- No refunds will be issued after the tryout date unless a player is unable to be placed on a team, medical reasons (not including Covid-19), or it is determined this league is not appropriate for the player.
- This league is run with volunteer coaches, anyone interested in helping coach should contact Community Education. Coaches will be required to complete Trusted Coaches background check and training. You will also be required to attend a Community Education Coaches meeting and a league meeting.
