You won't pay any additional fees to change to any qualifying calling plan or airtime promotion. Some calling plans require specific equipment. Calling plan changes and promotional offers will require a new 1- or 2-year customer agreement.

You can get a free phone every two years with New Every Two®.

Sign up for and maintain two years of service on a digital plan of \$34.99 or higher to qualify for a free phone up to \$50 or \$100, depending on the monthly access of your plan. Or you can apply your New Every Two credit toward the purchase of a more expensive phone. A two-year renewal is required.

Certain conditions and restrictions apply.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR NEW EVERY TWO

You are automatically enrolled when you sign up for a 2-year agreement on a calling plan with a monthly access of \$34.99 or higher. If you maintain service on a calling plan of \$34.99 or higher and fulfill your 2-year term, you will qualify for a free wireless device. If your calling plan monthly access is \$79.99 or higher for the entire three months prior to completing your New Every Two wireless device upgrade, you will get up to \$100 toward the purchase of that wireless device. If your calling plan monthly access was between \$34.99 and \$79.98 at any time during the three months prior to completing your New Every Two wireless device upgrade, you will get up to \$50 toward the purchase of that wireless device. When completing your New Every Two upgrade, you will need to renew your agreement for another two years on a calling plan with a monthly access of \$34.99 or higher. If you are not currently in the program, you can enroll by agreeing to a new 2-year term on a calling plan with a monthly access of \$34.99 or higher. Keep the power flowing. Here's everything you need to know about your battery.

Installing the Battery

Insert the bottom of the battery into the opening on the back of the phone, then push the battery down until the latch clicks.

Removing the Battery

Turn the phone off. Slide the battery cover downward and remove it. Press the top part of the battery to remove it.

Charging the Battery

To use the charger provided with your phone:

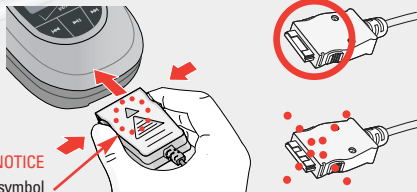
Warning! Use only the charger provided with the phone. Using any charger other than the one included with VX8300 may damage your phone or battery.

- 1.) Plug one end of the AC adapter into the phone's charger port and the other into an electrical outlet.
- 2.) The charge time varies depending upon the battery level.

NOTICE

Use an LG-approved charger or other accessories when you attach them to your phone.

Incorrect and improper handling of the jack may damage your phone (See the illustration).

POWERING THE PHONE ON AND OFF

Turn your phone on and get ready to start calling.

Powering the Phone On

- 1.) Install a charged battery or connect the phone to an external power source such as a cigarette lighter charger or hands-free car kit.
- 2.) Press  until the LCD screen lights up.

Powering the Phone Off




Press and hold  until the display turns off.

PLACING AND RECEIVING CALLS

Try out your new phone by making your first call. Here's how you do it:


Placing Calls


When you make a call, follow these simple steps:

- 1.) Make sure the phone is turned on. If not, press  for a few seconds.
- 2.) Enter the phone number, with lock code (if needed).
- 3.) Press . If the phone is locked, enter the lock code (The code is the last four digits of your phone number).
- 4.) Press  to end the call.

Receiving Calls

- 1.) To answer a call, press  or open the flip.

If you press Left Soft Key  **[Quiet]** while the phone is ringing, the ringing or vibration is muted for that call.










If you press Right Soft Key  **[Ignore]** while the phone is ringing, the call will end.

- 2.) Press  to end the call.

PROGRAMMING AND USING SPEED DIAL NUMBERS


Need a number fast? Don't worry; we've got you covered with speed dialing.

Programming Speed Dial Numbers

- 1.) Press Right Soft Key  [Contacts], then use  to select an entry.
- 2.) Press Left Soft Key  [Edit].
- 3.) Use  to select a phone number, then press Right Soft Key  [Options].
- 4.) Press  **Set Speed Dial**, then press .
- 5.) Press  **Yes**, then press  to save.











Using Speed Dial

- 1.) Enter a speed dialing number 02 to 99 (Number 1 is always assigned to Voice Mailbox).
- 2.) Press  .

CHANGING RINGERS AND TONES

When your phone rings, make sure you like the way it sounds. Here's how to pick a Ringer or Tone:

Selecting a Ringer or Tone



- 1.) Press  [MENU] and press  twice.
- 2.) From the **SETTINGS & TOOLS** Menu, press  **Sounds Settings**.
- 3.) Press  **Call Sounds** and then press  **Call Ringtone**.
- 4.) Select either **Caller ID/No Caller ID/Restricted Calls/All Calls** to change the ringer, and press .
- 5.) Select the desired ringer.
- 6.) Press Left Soft Key  [Play] to listen to ringer.
- 7.) To select the desired ringer press .

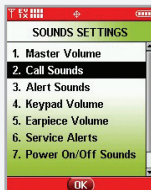
Your phone comes with a selection of ringtones. You can also purchase many more ringtones through our **GET IT NOW** service.

Adjusting Ringer or Tone Volume

Press Side Keys  up and down.

Setting Ringer or Tone to Vibrate

- 1.) Press  for 3 seconds.
- 2.) To reset, press and hold down .

- 1.) Press and hold **1** or dial ***86** **8** **6** and press **SEND**.
The phone calls voicemail.
- 2.) At the recording, press the **#**.
- 3.) Follow the voice prompts to set up your account.

Existing Customer

Press ***86** **8** **6** and press **SEND**.

Formatting your memory card

Step 1: Turn on phone.

Step 2: Insert microSD card into microSD memory card slot.

Step 3: Press and hold Play/Pause key on the front of the phone.

Step 4: Remove memory card from the phone and insert into the USB memory card adapter and connect to PC via USB memory card reader (if needed).

Step 5: On PC, go to file directory, locate “Removable Disk.” Open the folder named My_Music.

Step 6: Place WMAs in the My_Music folder.

Step 7: Reinsert microSD card into the phone.

How to Purchase Songs From Your Phone

Step 1: Go to your phone's "Get It Now" menu. Select "Get Tunes & Tones" and then "Get V CAST Music" to open the V CAST Music catalog.

Step 2: Browse or search the catalog to preview and choose the songs you want.

Step 3: Select the music you want to purchase.

Step 4: The "Purchase Confirmation Screen" will display the price and items you selected to purchase. Click "Buy" to accept.

Step 5: You'll receive confirmation that your purchase was successful and your music is available for download.

Step 6: Select "Download Now" to save the song to your phone, preferably to the memory card. You can then play your new song from "Manage Music" or from the "My Music" menu.

Note: Every song purchased from your phone also comes with a second, higher-quality copy. To access it, please log in to the V CAST Music Online Store accessible from within Windows Media™ Player 10.

How to Purchase Music From The V CAST Music Online Store to Your PC

Use Windows Media™ Player 10* to access the V CAST Music Online Store. There you can browse, preview and select new songs. Just purchase the songs you want and once downloaded they are automatically added to your Windows Media Player library.

How to Play Songs With Your Phone Open

- Step 1:** Go to the “Get It Now” menu and select “Get Tunes & Tones.” Then, open the “My Music” gallery and select a song or a playlist to play.
- Step 2:** With your stereo headset plugged in, close your phone, and continue listening to your songs. You can use the buttons on the outside of your phone to control your playback.

*Windows Media™ Player 10 is only supported on computers within the Windows® XP operating system. Windows and Windows Media are either registered trademarks or trademarks of Microsoft Corporation in the United States and/or other countries.

How to Play Songs With Your Phone Closed

You can also start the music player while the handset is closed by pressing and holding the “Play” key. The music player will begin playing all the music stored on your phone.

How to Sync Music From Your PC to Your Phone

Step 1: Use the USB cable to connect your phone to your PC.

Step 2: Go to the “Get It Now” menu and select “Get Tunes & Tones”, then select “Sync Music”.

Step 3: Open Windows Media™ Player 10 on your PC and select the “Sync” tab.

Step 4: Select “Edit Playlist” and select the songs from your library that you want to sync.

Step 5: In Windows Media™ Player 10, select “V CAST Mobile Phone – Removable Storage Card” unless no memory card is available. Start the sync process in Windows Media™ Player 10 by pressing “Start Sync”. Remember, your phone must be in “Sync Music” mode.

Step 6: When syncing completes, disconnect the cable from your phone and exit “Sync Music”.

Step 7: Under the “Get Tunes & Tones” menu, open “Manage Music” or “My Music” to view and play your music.

Note: V CAST Music phones only support music imported from a CD via Windows Media™ Player 10, purchased from the V CAST Music Service, or other purchased Windows Media™ formatted music. iPod® and iTunes® compatible music files are not compatible with V CAST Music.

How to Create Playlists on Your Phone

- Step 1:** Go to the “Get It Now” menu, select “Get Tunes & Tones” and select “Manage Music”. After the application is open, select “Playlists”.
- Step 2:** Under the “Playlists” menu, select the “Options” menu to create a new playlist and give it a title.
- Step 3:** You can now select songs to add by browsing through your library of music.
- Step 4:** Choose “Add this song to a Playlist” from the “Options” menu to add them to a playlist.

How to Edit Playlists on Your Phone

- Step 1:** To rearrange your songs, go back to the “Playlists” menu and select a playlist.
- Step 2:** Open the “Options” menu and select “Edit This Playlist”.
- Step 3:** You can add, reorder or remove songs from your playlist.

How to Delete Songs From Your Phone

- Step 1:** Go to “My Music” and select the song you want to erase.
- Step 2:** Open the “Options” menu and select “Erase” to erase the song.
- Step 3:** Select “Erase All” to erase all the songs on your memory card or your phone.

Note: If you erase music you’ve previously purchased, you can simply re-sync with your PC to add the song back to your phone’s music library.

V CAST Music Frequently Asked Questions







- Q.** Are iPod® and iTunes® music files compatible with my V CAST Music-capable phone?
- A.** No. Only music imported from a CD via Windows Media™ Player 10, purchased from the V CAST Music service or other purchased Windows Media formatted music are compatible.
- Q.** What are the system requirements?
- A.** To access the V CAST Music Online Store from a PC or to transfer music from your PC to a Verizon Wireless V CAST Music phone, you will need both the Windows® XP operating system and Windows Media Player 10. V CAST Music is not compatible with Mac OS X®.
- Q.** How can I transfer purchased music from my PC to my V CAST Music phone?
- A.** Music can be transferred using your V CAST Music phone's USB cable.
- Q.** Where can I store music if the memory on my phone is full?
- A.** Music can also be stored to a compatible external memory card. External memory cards should only be used for storage and not for transferring files.
- Q.** If I delete a song which I purchased from my V CAST Music phone, how do I retrieve the song later?
- A.** Whenever you purchase a song directly from your V CAST Music phone, you also receive as part of that purchase a second, higher quality copy of the song sent to your account on the V CAST Music Online Store. Please download this song file to your online music library, and re-sync the song to your V CAST Music phone using a phone-compatible USB cable and Windows Media™ Player 10.

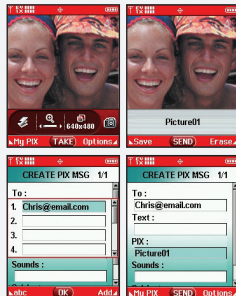



Snapping and Sending a Picture

- 1.) Press  from Standby mode.
- 2.) Using the phone screen as your viewfinder, press  to take a picture.
- 3.) Press  again to prepare to send. Picture is saved to **My PIX**.
- 4.) Enter a Verizon Wireless phone number or any e-mail address, and press . Up to 10 recipients can be added to each picture message.
- 5.) Use the center navigation Key  Up/Down to edit **Text**, **PIX**, **Sounds**, and **Subject**.
- 6.) Press  **[SEND]**.





Creating Picture Caller IDs

- 1.) Press the center navigation Key  Left.
- 2.) Press  **My PIX**.
- 3.) Select your desired picture with the center navigation Key  and press Right Soft Key  **[Options]**.
- 4.) Select **Set As** using the center navigation Key  Up/Down then press .
- 5.) Select **Picture ID** and press , then select name from contact list using the center navigation Key  Up/Down and press .

Storing a Picture on Your Phone

- 1.) Snap the photo and press  [TAKE]. Select Left Soft Key  [Save].
The picture is stored in **My PIX**.

Sending a Message Using a Picture Stored in the Phone's Gallery







- 1.) Press the center navigation Key  Left.
- 2.) Press  **My PIX**.
- 3.) Select your desired picture with the center navigation Key  and press Right Soft Key  [Options].
- 4.) Select **Send** and press .
- 5.) Enter a Verizon Wireless phone number or any e-mail address, and press . Up to 10 recipients can be added to each picture message.
- 6.) Press the center navigation Key  Up/Down to edit **Text**, **PIX**, **Sounds**, and **Subject**.
- 7.) Press  [SEND].

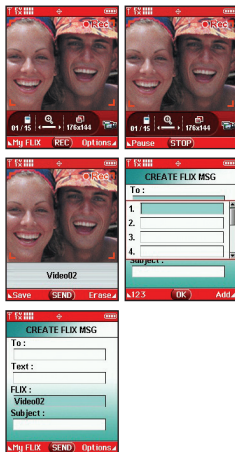

Recording and Sending a Video Message

- 1.) Press  twice from standby mode.
- 2.) Using the phone screen as your viewfinder, press  to begin recording (up to 15 seconds per video) and again to stop.
- 3.) Press  to prepare to send. Video is saved to **My FLIX**.
- 4.) Enter any email address, and press . Up to 10 email address can be added to each video message.
- 5.) Press the center navigation Key  Up/Down to edit **Text**, **FLIX**, and **Subject**.
- 6.) Press  [SEND].

Storing a Video Message on Your Phone

- 1.) Press  twice to enter the FLIX mode.
- 2.) Using the phone screen as your viewfinder, press  to begin recording and again to stop (up to 15 seconds per video).
- 3.) Record the video and select Left Soft Key  [**Save**]. The video is automatically stored in **My FLIX**.

Video Messages are charged in accordance with your Video Messaging plan.

TXT MESSAGING

Sending a New TXT Message

- 1.) Press Left Soft Key  [Message].
- 2.) Enter  **New Msg** and select **TXT Msg**.
- 3.) Enter the phone number or e-mail address of the recipient and press .
- 4.) Enter the message up to 160 characters, and press  to send the message.

For text options, press the Left Soft Key  for **Word**, **Abc**, **ABC**, **123** and **Symbols**.

You can also press  to change the case of a letter.


Fees apply for text messages/alerts both sent and received.




















TXT Messages are charged in accordance with your TXT Messaging plan.

Predictive TXT Input

Type text using one keystroke per letter. The phone translates keystrokes into common words by using the letters on each key and a compressed database.



From the text message screen, press Left Soft Key  to change the case to T9 Mode.

For example, follow these steps:



- 1.) From text message screen, press the Left Soft Key  **Abc** and select  **Word**.
- 2.) Press     .
- 3.) Press  to complete the word and add a space.
- 4.) Press           .
- 5.) The display shows **Call the office**.

USING GET IT NOW WITH V CAST

Accessing Get It Now with V CAST

- 1.) In standby mode, press the navigation  right to display the Get It Now Menu .
 - Options from here:

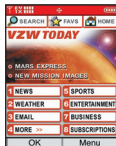

Pairing the Device

1. Follow the Bluetooth® accessory instructions to set the device to pairing mode.
2. Press  [MENU],  2 times, ,  or . Set the desired device to pairing.
3. If Bluetooth® power is set to off, you will be prompted to turn power on. Select  **Yes** and press .
4. The device will appear in the **found devices** list menu once it has been located. Highlight the device and press .
5. The handset will prompt you for the passcode. Consult the Bluetooth® accessory instructions for the appropriate passcode (typically “0000” - 4 zeroes). Enter the passcode and press .
6. Once pairing is successful, select  **Yes** and press  to connect with the device.

7. Once connected, you will see the device listed in the **Paired Devices** menu and the Bluetooth® device connected icon  will show up on your enunciator when connected to the BT device. You can also check out the connection with a blue icon on the list.

Power








Allows you to set the Bluetooth® power On/Off.

1. Press  **[MENU]**,  2 times, .
2. Press Left Soft Key  **[On]**.

Discovery Mode

Allows you to set Hidden/Shown To All.

1. Press  **[MENU]**,  2 times, .
2. Press Right Soft Key  **[Settings]**.
3. Press  **[Discovery Mode]**.
4. Use  to select a setting, then press .

Note: If you choose Shown To All for Discovery Mode, your device is able to be searched by other in-range Bluetooth® devices.

Transferring Audio

When a Bluetooth® audio device is connected, **Use Bluetooth / Use Phone** is displayed in the options menu for call state.
