It was a rich musical tradition that came to an end when the Venetian Republic surrendered to Napoleon, leaving music education in the north of Italy in chaos. It was Mayr who would eventually become the leading light in the reform and establishment of new music 'conservatori', his own school in Bergamo producing many fine musicians, for example Donizetti. Sisara was the second of his four oratorios composed for the orphaned girls of the Mendicanti to perform. The composer wrote of the oratorio's success in his Notebooks. There was 'amazing approval with a continual flock of listeners, eager each time to admire the excellent and animated performance, in particular that of the famous Bianca Sacchetti who was the last teacher and director of the Mendicanti'. It could be argued that Mayr's career was launched by the oratorio's success. Beautifully scored for female voices and an orchestra requiring skilled players, the music reveals not only Mayr's gift for melody but also his remarkable use of obbligato instruments which was to eventually change the development of Italian nineteenth century music. Guild's recording enables the listener to share something of the enthusiasm for those first performances due to an orchestra of period instruments under the direction of Franz Hauk.
