

The Elliot has a wonderful collection of Early Fords including many 'one of a kind' examples. 54 vehicles are enclosed in a climate controlled environment and are "served up" to a rotating viewing stage by a state of the art automated racking system. Our Guide, Dave, told us about Sterling Elliott, a turn of the 20th century inventor who created the steering knuckle, a fundamental advancement. which made the modern automobile possible. An avid bicycle enthusiast, he invented self-equalizing brakes and the pneumatic tire. The Elliott addressing machine brought fame and fortune to the family and his son. Harmon built the first museum on the site in his father's honor. Not


only does the Museum house historic automobiles and trucks, but there are permanent collections including Evinrude Outboard Boat motors, Baseball cards and late 19th Century memorabilia. NEXT STOP, THE HOUSE OF REFUGE



The last of 10 Houses of Refuge, this is a maritime museum featuring what sailors and passengers would have experienced after being saved from shipwrecks off the Florida coast in the 19th and early 20th Centuries. Boats traveling up the Intercostal would stop, deliver supplies and pick up the stranded passengers for the trip up to Jacksonville. Refugees could spend months there waiting! Our guide told us the most refugees from ships wrecked off the coast at any one time numbered 22 at this station. Living here was very rugged, but it surely beat the alternative! Fresh, potable water was recovered and held in a cistern. Protein was derived from shelling, fishing and hunting. No

food or vegetables could be grown on the Island since there is not enough soil for sustenance.

The refugees were quartered in the loft above and the "House Keeper" lived with his family on the main floor. The pictures are of the House Keeper's quarters.







WHAT'S MISSING FROM YOUR OIL MAY BE DESTROYING YOUR ENGINE

What is ZDDP? There seems to be a problem with the oil you are probably using in your TBird. An oil additive known as ZDDP (Zinc Dialkyl Dithio phosphate) has been gradually removed from commercially available engine oils.

There are two main reasons for the diminishing use of ZDDP in our oils. First, the EPA has required new car auto makers to guarantee that catalytic converters will last 100K miles. The use of ZDDP is hard on catalytic converters. Second, cars that have roller rocker assemblies do not need ZDDP.

What does ZDDP do for our engines? ZDDP is a surface modifier. It modifies bearing to journal surface characteristics to prevent metal to metal contact. Under the right conditions of heat and pressure it plates over the contact surface and provides a sacrificial coating. As it breaks down, it dissipates into the oil where it remains in suspension until the right conditions are met and the process starts over again. This cycle reduces the possibility of scuffing and galling.

We have spoken to our cam supplier and they agree that currently available oils are different and they would suggest using an additive that replaces the missing ZDDP. How do we replace ZDDP? CASCO has reviewed the available products and have settled on a product called ZDDPlus. ZDDPlus is a concentrated 4 ounce bottle that you simply add at every oil change. It is recommended for all engines built before 1988 that have flat tappet setups. We offering ZDDPlus as part number Z4 which sells for \$10.35 per 4 ounce bottle.






