### Mandate of Frontex

Frontex plays a key role in...

- Supporting EU countries and Schengen associated countries in managing their external borders
- Harmonising border controls across the EU
- Facilitating co-operation between border authorities in each EU country
- Providing technical support and expertise

"Support the development of technical standards for equipment ... to ensure interoperability at Union and national level"

#### **Research and Innovation Unit**


- Tasked to proactively monitor and contribute to research and innovation activities relevant for border control

### Harmonisation of EU Border Control Capacities

Support the development and harmonisation of EU Member States' border control capacities

#### How?

- Examine areas of common practices
- Identify capability needs
- Develop guidelines, soft standards and capability tools
- Support the roll out and implementation of new technologies for border control
- Disseminate current practices, challenges/benefits and capability needs among relevant stakeholders

- Guidelines for Processing of Non-EU Nationals through Automated Border Control








Harmonised training capabilities for ABC systems...


### **Developed Products**

#### Vulnerability Assessment and Testing for ABC systems:

- Concepts and basics of vulnerability assessment
- Methods of assessment and testing
- Biometric and non-biometric attacks
- Testing and mitigation of security risks on ABC systems

#### Developed

- In co-operation with BSI (German Federal Office for Information Security)
- Biometric attacks: special study carried out on image morphing

### Why are these products important?

- Clarification of key operational, technical, and legal aspects of ABC implementations
- Safeguarding an efficient and effective management of ABC systems through harmonised training
- Consideration of the complexities of ABC-related duties and activities

Also...

- First EU-wide harmonised ABC training capability
- Conform the European Sectorial Qualification Framework (SQF) for border guarding







### **Planned activities**

- Risk Management Workshop for ABC and biometric systems
- Performance Assessment Methodology for Document Inspection Systems

#### Products in the pipeline...

- Common Procurement Guidelines for Automated Border Control (ABC) Systems
- ABC Challenge Catalogue
- Revision of current ABC training tools + availability to non-EU countries on case-by-case basis
