### Defensive Pistol ~ November 4th





The first photo is Stage 1. The shooter is playing poker in a casino with 3 other people (no shoot targets). The shooter must engage the "bad guys" while avoiding the other players at the table.

The second photo, the truck is situated as if it has driven through the wall. The shooter does not know what is behind the wall. However, the shooter knows all of the bad guys have suicide vests. Accordingly, all shots must be to the head. When the timer goes off, the shooter approaches the entry and turns to the left around a corner and engages two targets in a room where there is the wrecked truck and a number of no shoot targets as well. As the shooter advances into the room there is another target. The shooter then comes to a corner. From the corner, the shooter engages two more targets. Turning right into another room, the shooter advances to another corner. From that corner the shooter engages 6 targets, one of which is a swinging target, without shooting any of the hostages. Turning right and advancing into the now cleared room, the shooter comes to a doorway. From the doorway, the shooter engages 4 more targets, again avoiding hostages, and shoots two IDPA targets (head only) a steel target and a popper. No one got to see the course of fire before they shot it.





# Cowboy Silhouette



November 18, 2017 - Cowboy Silhouette is a match of offhand rifle shooting. The small-bore rifle can be any lever action, pump or semi-auto rim-fire rifle with a tubular magazine (No bolt actions rifles), .22 long rifle ammunition only, hyper velocity ammunition prohibited. The center-fire rifle can be any lever action rifle with a tubular magazine. A rimmed pistol cartridge must be used, i.e. 25-20, 32-30, 38's, 357 magnum, 38-40, 44's, 44-40, 45 Colt, 45 long Colt, 22 magnum, 22 long rifle. The targets are metallic animals set at different distances, so you get to use some "Kentucky windage" if you like. Aftermarket sights are allowed, but no scopes. There is one more Cowboy Silhouette match for 2017, it will be held on December 16th. Grab you rifle and at least 50 rounds of ammo for each match and head to the range on the 16th, you will be shooting with a great group of folks. ## Smallbore Silhouette



November 25, 2017 Smallbore Silhouette, 2 days after Thanksgiving was a fun match as always. What is better than a day at the range with good friends, all trying to hit more targets than the rest. This was the last Smallbore Silhouette match for the year the next match will be in March 2018. That gives all of you not already addicted to get your rifle ready. All you need is a .22 caliber rifle and a steady hold. Scopes are allowed and encouraged and the ammunition is any .22 short, long, or long rifle cartridge, standard-velocity but "high" or "hypervelocity" (Stingers, Vipers, etc.) are not allowed. It is extremely helpful if you have sighted your rifle in at the various distances (40 meters, 60 meters, 77 meters and 100 yards) and have recorded the sight settings prior to the match. 
