

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

MASS WITH YOUR CHILDREN

Begin your preparation at home:

Pray as a family. Use the language and prayers that the children will hear at Mass - Amen, Alleluia, The Our Father; Holy, Holy, Holy, or Glory to God.

As you pray at home, model how to make the Sign of the Cross, how to hold your hands in prayer, how to bow your head, how to genuflect, etc.

Read the Gospel aloud before you go to Church.

Sit in the front:

Small children will become easily bored if they are unable to see what is happening during liturgy. Sit as close to the front as possible so that you can share with your child what is going on during liturgy.

Hold your little ones up so that they can see the gestures, vessels and colors.



THIS WEEK'S RECOMMENDATION:

Compost. Food scraps and yard waste together currently make up about 30 percent of what we throw away, so consider composting instead. Making compost keeps these materials out of landfills where they take up space and release methane, a potent greenhouse gas. Your compost can then be used to enrich soil and reduce the need for fertilizer. 
