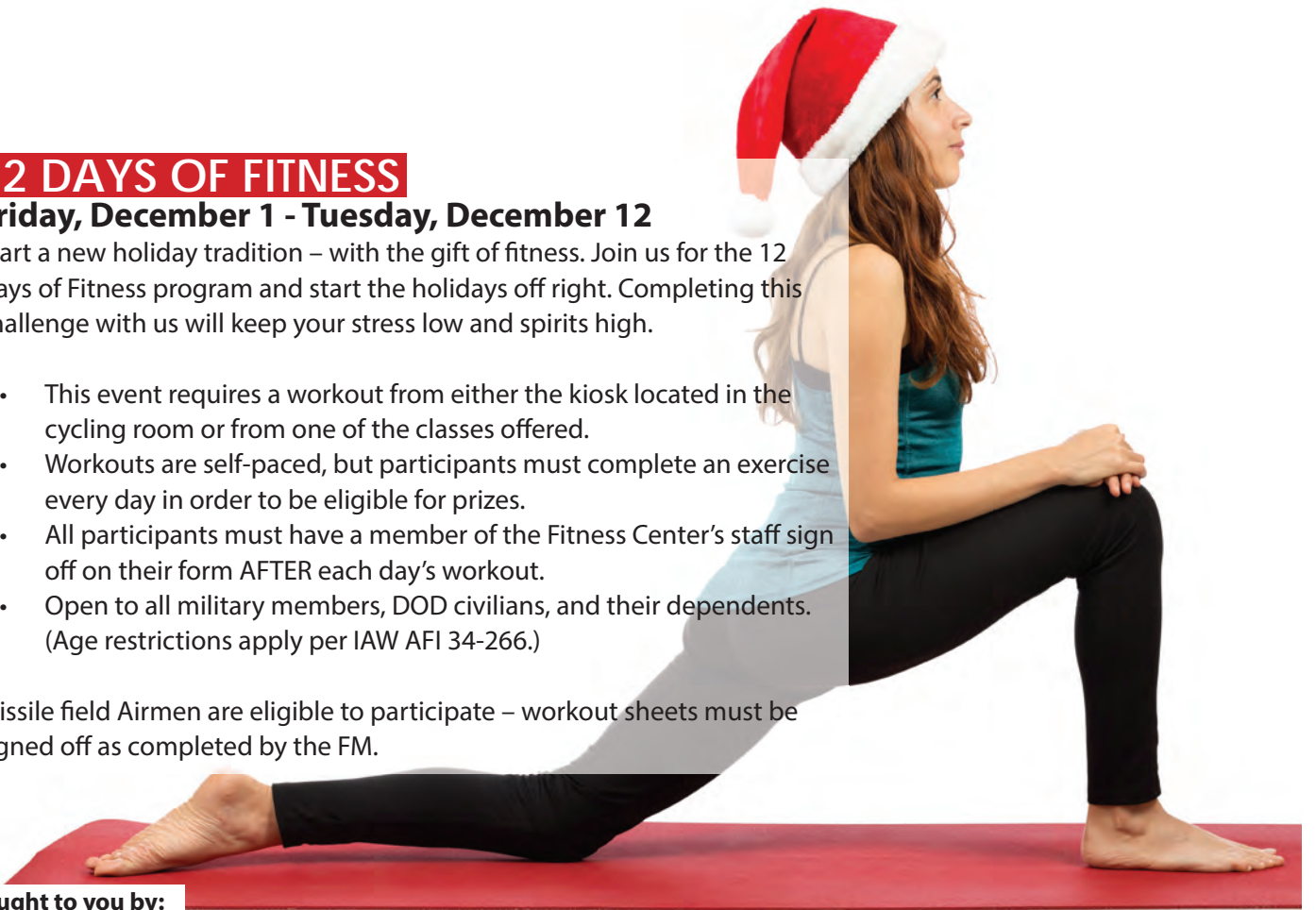
12 DAYS OF FITNESS

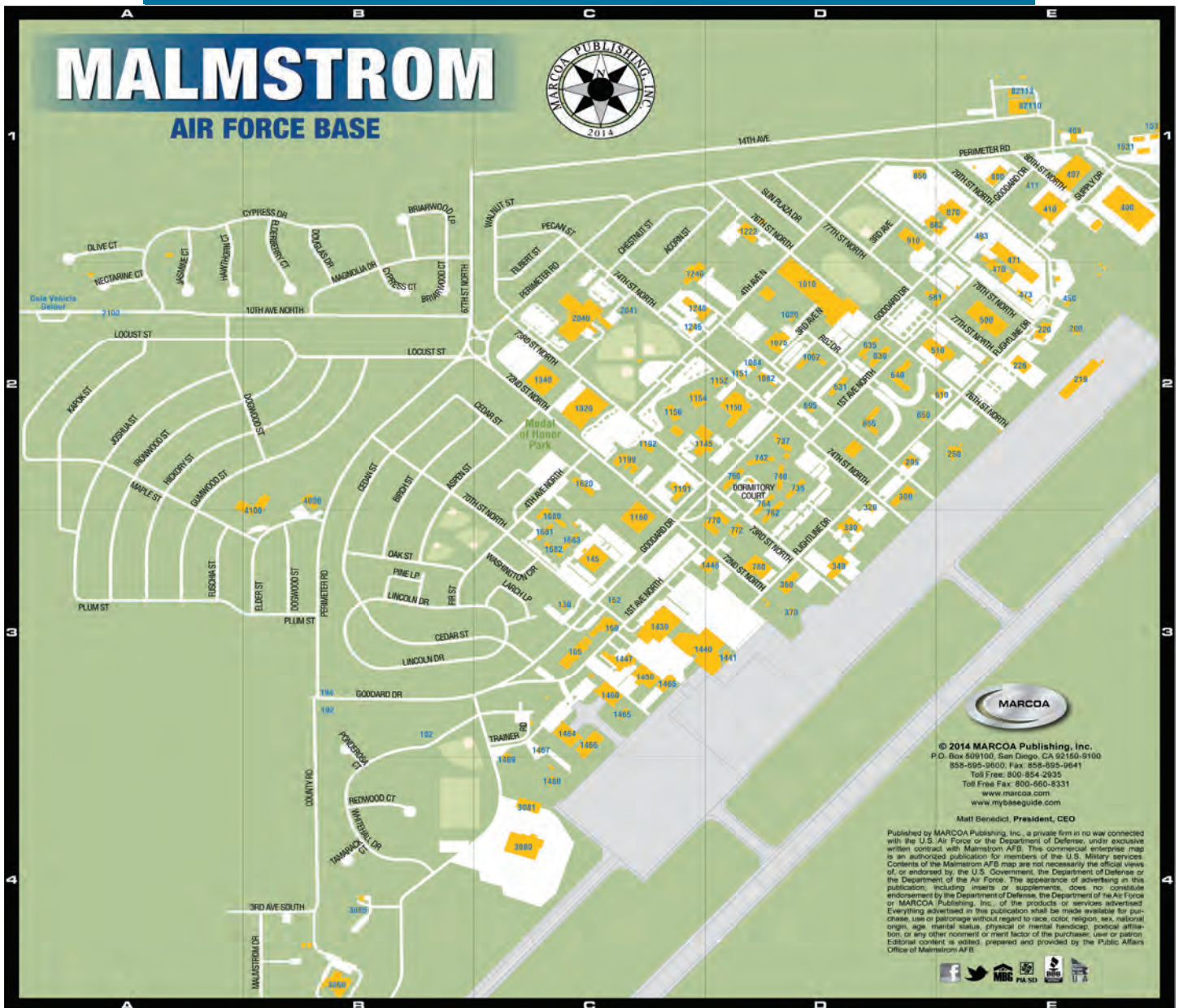
