Parking issues

We have been contacted by the Shire of Yarra Ranges and asked to pass on some information relating to parking during school drop-off and pick-up times. The request follows routine inspection by the Council traffic officer on 17/9/18.

These inspections are randomly organised by Council staff and the school is not notified as to when they will happen, nor does the school request such inspections. They are done to ensure the safety of our children, compliance with Road Safety issues and in response to complaints from residents.

We have been asked to notify our school community of the following:

- Please do not park on any nature verges. If an infringement notice is issued, a photograph will be taken as evidence to ensure that the ticket complies with local regulations.
- Please do not obstruct footpaths or driveways. Local residents need to be able to access their driveways at all times and children and families need to be able to safely walk along the footpaths to and from the school.
- If you are part of the line-up for the drive through—please ensure that you do not block High St (cnr View St).

While traffic management and enforcement of regulations is a matter for the council and its workers, the safety of our students and local community is the responsibility of all of us.

As we head off for a well-earned 2 week break I would like to thank all of our wonderful staff for their hard work this term. We are very fortunate to be part of a great school community. I hope all of our staff and families have a relaxing and enjoyable holiday. We look forward to returning for what will be a very busy and exciting Term 4.
