- ⇒ Patients with Medicare Part D might be considered if they are ineligible for Low Income Subsidy and have spent at least 5% of their annual household income (out of pocket) on medications.
- Medications will be shipped to your Doctor's office for your pick up.

Novolog Insulin



- A <u>free 90 day supply</u> to patients that do not have insurance and do not qualify for Medicare, Medicaid or Veterans programs.
- Exceptions include patients who have entered the coverage gap in Medicare part D (donut hole) and patients who have applied for and were denied Medicare Extra Help/Low Income Subsidy (LIS) and are Medicare eligible. Instructions on how to apply are below: (Can take 3 weeks before patient actually receives insulin)

You and your doctor must fill out and mail or fax the completed application, along with your <u>proof of income</u>.

- Keep a photocopy of your application and your original income documents. If approved, your medication will be shipped to your doctor's office.
- You will remain enrolled in the program for up to 1 year. To continue receiving free Lilly medicines, you must reapply each year.

Help with Diabetes testing supplies



- Free Style brand test strips and lancets
- co-pay assistance for test strip refills for patients with insurance.
- This program provides patients with a reduced co-pay of \$15 per refill instead of the patient's original higher co-pay.
- Co-pay assistance is not valid for prescriptions reimbursed under Medicare, Medicaid, or similar federal or state programs or in Massachusetts.
- Eligible patients are responsible for the first \$15 of each co-pay under their insurance coverage; patients on high co-pay plans may have additional responsibility.
- Uninsured patients are also eligible in most situations.
 Free Style will provide patients with a new meter for free.
