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

Find these objects hidden in the picture below: football, fish, horseshoe, magnet, moon, ring, sock, spoon, star.



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


Just like you slowly began to see the hidden things in the picture, God wants us to slowly see more and more about him as we are wandering through these pandemic days.

The next morning, the ground was covered with something small and round. AND TASTY! 'Bread from heaven!' they said.




'God has sent manna for us to eat.'

Manna Recipe

Ingredients

- Package of Oyster crackers
- 1/4 cup margarine
- 1/4 cup honey



Instructions Mix honey with margarine and heat until it bubbles. Pour mixture over oyster crackers in a large bowl and toss gently to coat crackers lightly. Let dry.

The Israelites ate manna and quail (a type of bird) for 40 years! Each day, God would provide just what the Israelites needed. They didn't have to worry about what they were going to eat the next day they only needed to put their trust in God.




