And when it's dry and ready,


then dreidel I will play.

Oh Hanukkah, Oh Hanukkah, come light the menorah, Let's have a party, we'll all dance the horah,


Gather 'round the table, we'll give you a treat, dreydl to play with and latkes to eat.
