

# Quando, porém, vier o Espírito da Verdade, ele vos conduzirá à plena verdade.

Domingo da Santíssima Trindade: *Pr 8,22-31; Sl 8; Rm 5,1-5; Jo 16,12-15*.

O evangelho acentua que o mistério do amor de Deus Pai é revelado pelo Filho e permanece atuante através do Espírito. Jesus, antes de sua páscoa, orienta os discípulos a pautarem a vida com seus ensinamentos. As palavras e as ações realizadas pelo Mestre serão compreendidas plenamente após sua ressurreição, mediante o Espírito da Verdade que guiará em toda a verdade (16,13). O Espírito proporciona conhecer as Escrituras, o plano de amor do Pai realizado na obra redentora do Filho. A ação eficaz do Espírito Santo resulta da comunhão perfeita entre o Pai e o Filho: Eu e o Pai somos um (10,30). Tudo o que o Pai tem pertence a Jesus, pois foi revelado através de sua vida e missão. Como Jesus, glorificou o Pai pela obra salvífica (5,19-21), o Espírito glorificará Jesus, porque receberá do que é dele para anunciá-lo aos discípulos que realizarão grandes obras em seu nome: Quem crê em mim fará as obras que eu faço, e fará ainda maiores do que estas (14,12). A 1ª leitura salienta que a sabedoria divina está presente em todas as coisas criadas e se alegra em estar com os filhos dos homens. O salmo é um hino de louvor ao Criador pelas suas obras, sendo aplicado a Cristo coroado de honra e glória por causa de nossa salvação (Hb 2,5-9). A 2ª leitura ressalta que o amor de Deus manifestado na vida, morte e ressurreição de Cristo e derramado em nossos corações pelo Espírito Santo possibilita viver na esperança, que não decepciona.

Somos impelidos a "crer num só Deus que é Amor (cf. 1Jo 4,8): o Pai que enviou seu Filho para a nossa salvação; Jesus Cristo, que redimiu o mundo no mistério da sua morte e ressurreição; o Espírito Santo, que guia a Igreja através dos séculos enquanto aguarda o regresso glorioso do Senhor" (Porta da Fé).

Reunimo-nos para celebrar o louvor ao Pai, pelo Filho, no Espírito Santo. Participando do mistério trinitário comprometemo-nos a construir a unidade em todo o nosso viver.


