

Ash Wednesday — Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>. Our students will be going to Mass at either 4:00 or 7:00pm. Families are invited to attend Mass with their children.

- Students in grades 1-4 will attend Mass at 4:00pm.
- Students in grades 5–11 will attend Mass at 7:00pm.

Mass replaces their regular class for the week. Attendance at Mass is not optional!! Students may attend either Mass with their families if one is more convenient. Students must check-in with their teachers or in the parish office before Mass to verify attendance.


