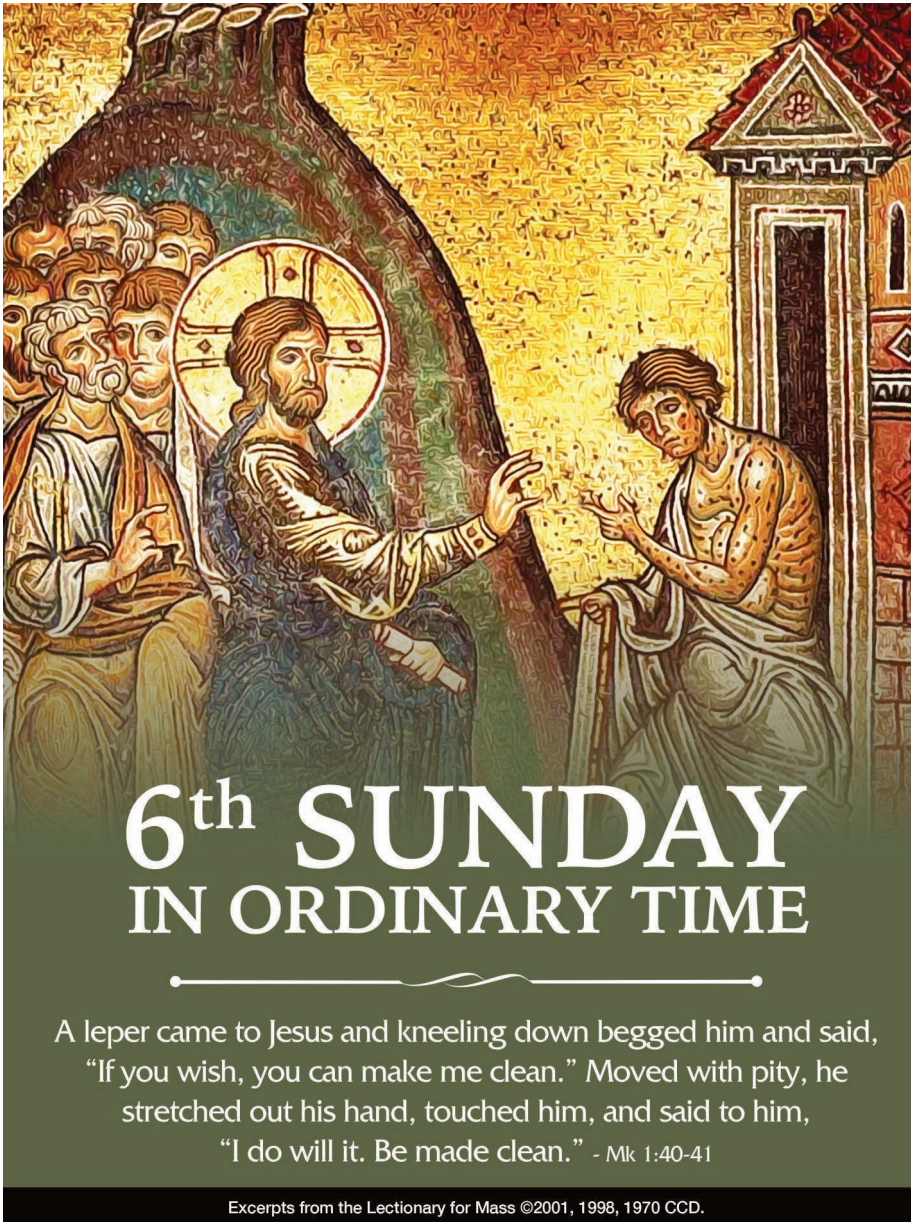

Ash Wednesday — Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday, February 14th. Our students will be going to Mass at either 4:00 or 7:00pm. Families are invited to attend Mass with their children.

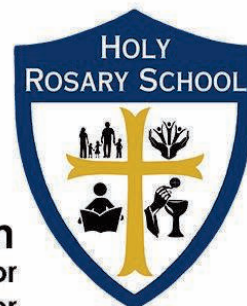
