A NOTE FROM FR. SCOTT | UNA NOTA DEL PADRE SCOTT

My Dear People,

Today in the Gospel, the disciples continue their streak of misunderstanding Jesus and His teachings. They get into a discussion with Jesus about who is in and who is out. Someone was driving out demons in Jesus' name, and the disciples were not happy about that. Jesus responds with "whoever is not against us is for us." Jesus tells his disciples that by their actions, you shall know them. If someone is not part of the group but is still performing the actions of the members of the group, the person is with us. Jesus meets the misunderstanding of the disciples by teaching them values contrary to their own experiences. The disciples continue to be formed into who Jesus dreams they will be.

Today at the 9:15AM Mass, we receive with joy Brooke Cushman and Larry Thomas into Full Communion with the Catholic Church. These brothers and sisters of ours, already one with us through baptism, have been preparing to enter the Church through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. They come to us from various religious backgrounds, and we are happy that their path has led them to us as they are Confirmed and receive the Lord for the first time in Holy Communion. Next weekend, we will welcome Fr. Joseph Tuscan, OFM Cap. to our parish on behalf of Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Fr. Tuscan was born in Columbus, OH and entered Borromeo College Seminary in 1986, where he earned a bachelor's degree in Behavioral Sciences. In 1993, he professed his Perpetual vows as a Capuchin Franciscan friar and earned his master's degree in Theology and was ordained to the priesthood in 1997. FOCUS is a national organization serving college students on more than 180 campuses across the United States and five international locations. Almost 800 FOCUS missionaries on these campuses invite students into a relationship with Christ and His Church, while equipping them for a lifetime of Catholic evangelization.
