2022 Parish Census

Thank you to everyone who has participated in our 2022 Parish Census. We have added 20 new families to our Parish Roster and gathered information on many people that we didn't have before.

Have you sent in your parish census?

There are still many who have not responded. Parish Census packets will be on the Information Table in the Church or you can access the same information on our website.

It has been many years since the Parish has updated its' Parishioner Database. Since the last update, many changes have occurred; people have moved (both in and out of Jersey City), children have been born, phone numbers have changed, etc... We do not have cell phone numbers and/or emails for many of our parish families. In addition to printing a weekly bulletin, we quite often communicate via email, so it is advantageous for us to have at least one email for each family.

In order to have a better understanding of who currently comprises our Parish community,

I am asking each of you to complete a "Parish Registration Card". Even if you do not feel that anything has changed, it would be very helpful to us if you would complete the card. If you have adult children living with you, it would be beneficial to the Parish to have them complete their own Parish Registration Card.

If you have never been registered with the Parish, now is the perfect opportunity to accomplish this. It is important for every Catholic to be registered with their Parish. As an active, registered parishioner (a person who attends Sunday Mass and observes Holy Days of Obligation), your participation in Parish life enables me to provide letters of recommendation to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, provided you meet all of the requirements. In addition, you will receive Parish mailings, news of the week via email, weekly contribution envelopes, which enables us to keep a record of your donations for income tax purposes each year, etc.

Please return the Card to us in the collection, by mail, or in person.

Parish Membership

Every Catholic should be registered in a Parish. To become a registered member of our Parish Family stop by or call the Parish Office. Only active, registered parishioners for at least 3 months can obtain letters of testimony for Godparents and Sponsors.

Sick Calls and Ministry to the Sick

Urgent calls will be attended at any time of day or night. In other cases of illnesses, prolonged or extended, please notify the Parish Office.

Upon request, Holy Communion will be brought to them by one of our Eucharistic Ministers or arrangements can be made with a Priest for a regular monthly visit.

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements should be made at least one year in advance and before you book your wedding venue.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents should arrange with the Parish Office for Baptism. Sponsor Certificates for Godparents are required. Parents are required to attend a Baptism class prior to Baptism.

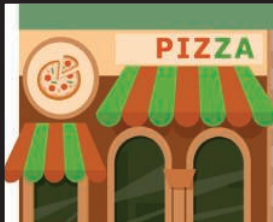

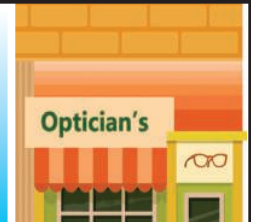
