Holy Trinity's Science Olympiad team competed at the Kearney Middle School (MO) Invitational over the weekend. The all-day event on Saturday was exciting with 17 of our 21 students competing in 23 STEM-rich events. Nearly 500 middle school students from 24 KS, MO and NE teams were at the event. Holy Trinity placed 17th place overall.

Our next invitational competition is in Warrensburg, MO on February 4. The regional competition will be at Johnson County Community College at the end of February, with the possibility of competing at the state competition in Wichita in April.
