DEDICATED AWARDS

Richard Poor Service to the Community Award

Dick Poor was one of the founders of the YMCA Athletic Achievement Awards Banquet, now called the Sports Award Banquet, which was started in 1966 and grew out of the Y's pioneering interest in, and emphasis on, sports and physical fitness as a means of character development. He served on the committee until his death. A member of the YMCA Board of Managers for many years, Dick was a career banker with a lifelong interest in both young people and sports. He had a strong dedication to the betterment of life in Bergen County.

Thomas L. Della Torre Special Achievement Award

Tommy Della Torre, renowned football coach, athletic director, disciplinarian, mentor, friend and member of the YMCA of Greater Bergen County's Board of Directors, was dedicated to youth, sports and family. This award is given to someone who embodies Tom's attributes and ideals, as well as the values of spirit, mind and body for which the YMCA stands.

J. Barry Stanford Award for Outstanding Achievement in High School Sports

This Special Achievement Award is given to recently graduated high school students who have received significant recognition in sports. It was renamed posthumously in honor of Barry Stanford, who served on the Sports Award Banquet Committee for over 30 years and was passionate about high school sports and the young people involved in them.

Nicholas G. Saingas Service to Youth Award for Contribution to High School Athletics

Although Nick Saingas did not join the Awards Committee until after his retirement from Public Service, he had been a strong supporter of the Sports Award Banquet for many years. An avid athlete all his life, he understood the importance of sports in the development of young people. His impact on others was great. He was a true friend to our youth and generously contributed his time and talents both to them and to activities which benefited their lives.

Walter E. Goepel Amateur Athlete of the Year Award

Involved with the YMCA of Greater Bergen County off and on throughout his life, Walt Goepel in his later years served on both the Sports Award Banquet Committee and the YMCA Board of Directors. Once a nationally ranked tennis player, he was a 12-time Bergen County tennis champion in both singles and doubles, and a New Jersey state singles champion.

William J. "Mickey" Corcoran Award

This award is named after the longtime Northern Highlands and River Dell athletic director and coach, Mickey Corcoran, whose service to the high school athletes in this area covers six decades. "The Mentor" was a long-time member of the YMCA Sports Award Committee and the Bergen County Coaches' Association Basketball Jamboree Committee. His contributions to high school athletics, the many students he helped, the countless number of coaches he counseled and friends he made along the way made Mickey one of the legendary figures in Bergen County athletic history.

PERSON OF THE YEAR

Ed Camp



Ed Camp, a Bergenfield native, whose career has spanned the ranks of local and national officiating, attained his ultimate achievement when he was hired by the National Football League in 2000. Now in his 20th year with the league, Ed has distinguished himself as a respected official, having earned numerous post season assignments, and now most notably, SUPERBOWL LIII in Atlanta.

He began officiating high school football and basketball in 1980, moving to the college ranks (in both sports) in 1984. Ed's collegiate officiating career spans NCAA Football Division 3, to the Ivy League, Patriot League, Yankee Conference, Atlantic 10 Conference and the Big East Conference.

Of note:

- 15 New Jersey State Finals in both Basketball and Football
- Two NCAA Division I-AA Football Playoffs
- Seven NCAA Division III Basketball Playoffs
- Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas (1998, USC vs. TCU)

Before joining the NFL, Ed worked five seasons in NFL-Europe, including the 1999 World Bowl in Dusseldorf, Germany. He has also officiated the following milestone games along the way:

- American Bowl in Osaka, Japan (Redskins vs. 49ers)
- Pro Bowl, Honolulu, Hawaii, 2004
- Hall of Fame Game, Canton, Ohio, 2009, 2016
- Inaugural NFL International Bowl, London, England (2007, Giants vs. Dolphins)
- Inaugural game to open MetLife Stadium, East Rutherford, NJ (2010, NY Giants vs. NY Jets)

With a strong commitment to give back to his community, Ed has served the NJFOA (NJ Football Officials Association, North Chapter) as a consultant for over 20 years. He trains entry level officials in the mechanics and philosophy of officiating. He donates his time and officiating skills to many charitable sporting events each year, such as the Boomer Esiason High School All-Star Football Game at Hofstra University to benefit the fight against Cystic Fibrosis and the Snow Bowl to benefit Special Olympics.

This award is Ed's second from the YMCA of Greater Bergen County; in 2002, he was awarded with the Special Achievement Award for Professional Excellence in Sports Officiating. He was a 2004 recipient of the John Goldsmith Award, for contributions to the officiating community, presented by the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Football Officials. He has been inducted into the North Jersey Semi-Pro Baseball Hall of Fame (1995) and the Northern Valley Demarest High School Athletic Hall of Fame (2018).

In addition to his NFL career, Ed taught Physical Education in the New York City School system, retiring after 32 years. A graduate of William Paterson University, with a B.S. in Physical Education, he also holds a Master's Degree in Athletic Administration from Montclair State University.

Ed resides with his wife Lynne, in Hawthorne, NJ. He has two married children, Matt Camp (Anna) and Casey Oldfield (Cliff). This year he became the very proud grandfather of Penny Camp and Millie Oldfield. "I am honored, and humbled, to receive this prestigious award! Thank you!"

Richard Poor Service to the Community

Wayne has been a member of the Closter Recreation Commission for over 15 years and currently serves as its President. He has coached youth basketball, soccer and baseball for all age levels from kindergarten up to high school. His coaching experiences include teams in Closter's recreation programs as well as Vikings Soccer Club teams, Northeast Bergen All Star baseball teams, PVISL indoor soccer teams and Dale Murphy League All Star baseball teams.



He has served as town Liaison to the PVISL Indoor Soccer League and also was an active member in the Northern Valley Demarest Booster Club where he was the liaison to the baseball team. He participated in raising funds for the procurement of a new scoreboard for the baseball field and organized the food concession for numerous Bergen County baseball tournaments held at NVD.

Wayne has served three stints as a Northeast Bergen All Star Baseball League Division Commissioner.

Wayne is a past President and Trustee of the Closter Coaches Association. With the help of a core group of coaches and support from Recreation Director Jim Oettinger they re-organized the Association in 2000 after it went dormant for several years. The Association worked in support of and in concert with the Recreation Commission to raise funds to establish training programs for the children and to provide other program enhancements. After the 9/11 tragedy the Association focused its fund-raising efforts in support of

local residents' whose family members had perished that day.

Wayne was a long-time chaperone for Closter Recreation's Ski Club participating in numerous Friday night ski trips to Mountain Creek Resort. He has been a volunteer at Closter's annual 5k run since 2000.

Wayne's proudest endeavor is his participation in Closter's Challenger program for the differently-abled. Wayne has been a Challenger basketball and baseball coach for over 15 years and has had the privilege of working with many dedicated coaches, amazing children and their parents during that time.

Wayne is presently a Committee member for Closter's Troop 63 BSA. He is a past Assistant Scoutmaster and has been involved with the Troop for over 15 years participating in numerous High Adventure trips, community service projects, fund-raisers and mentoring Scouts to attain their Eagle Rank including his two sons who are both Eagles.

Wayne also serves on Closter's Zoning Board of Adjustment and is a 16-year member of Closter Elks Lodge 2304.

Wayne and his wife Sandi moved to Closter 32 years ago after getting married and raised two children Michael 29 and Jeffrey 27. Michael Doherty is a 1982 graduate of Saint Joseph Regional HS, where he earned All-County honors while playing for two Bergen County Jamboree title teams under legendary coach Dennis Rossi. After graduating from Muhlenberg College (PA), where he played four years of basketball, Mike returned to teach English and coach at his alma mater, in September of 1986.



Mike's 33 year career at Saint Joe's has seen him wear many different hats, both in and out of the classroom. He is currently the Vice Principal and Director of Admissions at SJR, positions he has held for over 20 years.

Mike was named varsity basketball coach at Saint Joe's in 1989. During the last 30 years, his squads have a record of 488-269. SJR has captured two Bergen Jamboree titles (2005, 2016), two Bergen Invitational Tournament titles (2012, 2018) and four league championships under his watch.

Mike is a two-time Bergen County Coach of the Year honoree (2005, 2016) and was inducted into the New Jersey Scholastic Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2010.

Mike and his wife GloriaAnn, who are celebrating their 31st wedding anniversary today, have three sons: Matthew (26), Patrick (23) and Timothy (15). 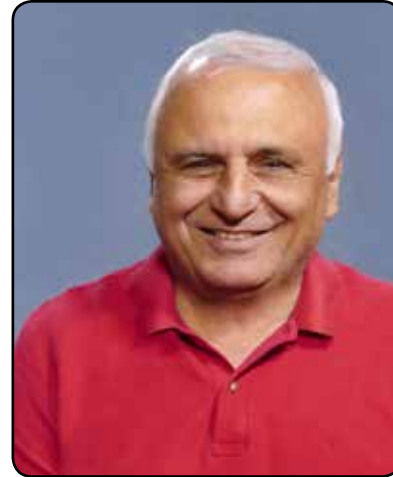
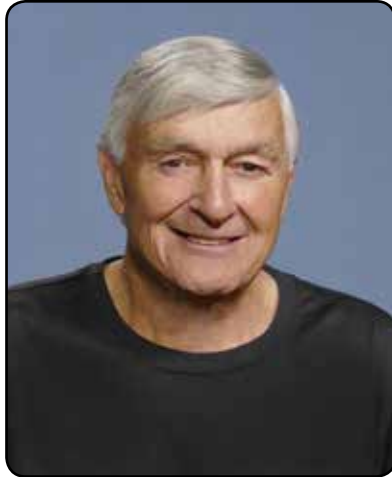

Chris continues to volunteer at his church as an altar server. After school he is a member of the Hand in Hand club, working with children who have special needs. Chris continues to run, often running 6 to 12 miles, several times per week. He has already run in one half-marathon and dreams about running in the New York City Marathon. Chris will be continuing his education in the fall at the Summit House in Norwood.

Their first championship broadcast game was in 1989 between St. Peter's Prep. and St. Joseph's Regional. They broadcast what was referred to as "The Game of the Century" between Paramus Catholic and Bergen Catholic in December of 1992. In 1994, when the high school football championship returned to Giant Stadium, they broadcast the inaugural game between St. Peter's Prep and Bergen Catholic.
