


To create great wealth find something that does not require your hands


No Patent Required!





Step 6 -Protect Your Idea With a Well-Written PPA

Google Image Search to understand the landscape

Prior Patent Search



USPTO - Take their class to learn how!
Can be done using outside search firm



Build a Prototype

Learn what works and what doesn't

Learn About Manufacturing



Watch YouTube videos

Contact contract manufacturer

Hire a consultant



Why go to all This Work?

Develop variations "Steal" it from yourself Stop work-arounds

Write Your PPA for U.S.



Use a software program

Hire attorney or patent agent



Include Drawings!

A drawing is worth a thousand words

If you plan to file internationally, then a patent attorney should draft at least one "claim".



Become the expert -You and only you.

Benefits of a PPA



- One year, patent pendingAffordable
- Can be done yourself
- Use the one year period determine if your product is marketable!
