## How to play Fall Classic Baseball

The batter card design has changed a little bit in the stat section at the bottom of the card since this file was produced.
The sba field also now contains the steals made state, for example Cabrera's now reads 4-5 / 1 (4 out of 5 made / jump rating 1) Dice rolls 51-53 now have the complete word Defense instead of the short form Def.


Roll 3 dice to activate an at bat. You need a red D6, a white D6, and a D20. If you do not have D20 dice then use a deck of playing cards. Take out the face cards and use just Aces through 10's. The reds can be 1-10 and the blacks 11-20.


You can choose to roll the D6 only and then roll the D20 afterwards to resolve a play. About two-thirds of the results only need the D6's for the play result.

The D6's are read as a 2 digit number with the red D6 always first. So, the above roll would be read as sixteen. When you look for the corresponding combination on the batter's card (highlighted with a red box around it) we see the result K, a strikeout.


Let's say the next dice roll for Cabrera is:


55 HOMERUN 1-13 / DOUBLE
He has a chance for a homerun or a double. Roll the D20 and if it's from 1-13 it's a homerun, and from 14-20 (the rest) it's a double.

This roll has 3 splits. Roll the D20 and if it's 1-4 it's a double.
If the D20 is $5-10$ it's a single with a chance for a stolen base (+). D20 from 11-20 (the rest) is a single.

All of the blank spots on dice rolls 31-45 and 56-64 send you to the pitcher's card for the corresponding number to look up. Dice roll 65 also sends you to the pitcher card to check for a homerun.

Bumgarner's pitching card is now displayed. On dice roll 34 Cabrera has a blank which means you refer to the pitcher's card. The first thing you have to do with the pitcher is determine which column to use for this game, either A (good stuff), B (average), or C (not so good). Roll a D20 when he enters the game and refer to the bracketed number beside the letter. Let's say the D20 roll is 4. Bumgarner would use column A and have his good stuff for the game. This roll is made just once when the pitcher enters.

On dice roll 34 he gets the OUT. If he had been in column $B$ or $C$ he would have given up a single.

Dice roll 32 looks like Bumgarner is worse in column A as he gives up a double (DBL) on D20 1-2. But, if you look at the whole section from 3136 take note that column B has 2 full hits, column $C$ has 3 full hits, while column A has only 1 full hit and a very slim chance ( 2 out of 20) of a second hit, the double.

A D20 roll is needed on dice roll 65 for a homerun check. Column A only gives up a homerun if the D20 is 1-3. D20 4-20 is an out. He gets progressively worse in columns B and C.

Wherever there is a split and the D20 does not fall within the split area, then it is considered an OUT. Refer to the OUT charts to see what type of out is made. If you are familiar with baseball's scoring system you will have a quick way to determine most outs. Here's the system:

1-P ... 2-C ... 3-1B ... 4-2B ... 5-3B ... 6-SS ... 7-LF ... 8-CF ... 9-RF
With that in mind, just refer to the D20 to see how most outs go. Refer to the last digit of the D20.
-1 or 11 is a groundout to the pitcher
-3 or 13 is usually a groundout to the 1 st baseman

- 4 or 14 a groundout to the 2 nd baseman
- 5 or 15 is usually a groundout to the 3 rd base
-6 or 16 is a groundout to the shortstop
-7 or 17 is a flyout to the leftfielder
- 8 or 18 is a flyout to center
- 9 or 19 is a flyout to right

So let's play a few innings with the Tigers batting against Bumgarner to see how the game is played.


I prefer rolling the D20 with the D6's in case it's needed. I'm not a fan of rolling a 2nd time to resolve the play except for special results.

Jackson has a blank at 63, so we refer to Bumgarner's 63 in column A.

His KD number 5 does NOT cover the D20, thus no strikeout. Now a defense check is made.

Roll the D6's again and refer to the Defense Chart. Some gamers like to roll all 3 dice again. I like to wait on the D20 roll for added suspense.


The Defense Chart is made up of 3 columns, one for dice roll 51 , one for dice roll 52, and one for dice roll 53. Error checks are made on dice rolls 51 and 52 , and range checks are made on dice roll 53.

The letter X that follows the word OUT means that if there had been a man on first base, it would have been an automatic ground double play with less than 2 out.

The X overrides any other play description in the Out Charts on groundouts, for example:

The white die is NOT 1 so the runner does NOT advance to 2 nd. Instead there's a DP chance.
Peralta the SS has an A arm, thus it's a 6-4-3 GDP. W arms would only have gotten a choice at 2nd. That ends the inning.

BTW, Blanco actually did not hit into any GDP's in 2012. It brings up one of those dilemmas for game engines. A code could certainly be added to the OUT. There already is OUT x to make GDP's automatic. If he had an OUT x there would not have been any arm check. It just would have happened, period. So why not add a new symbol for Blanco who had no GDP's, something like OUT nox?

This symbol would also have to appear in all the blanks from 31-65 to prevent forgetting about it. The card then gets cluttered and loses its aesthetic appeal. It's not like Blanco never hit into GDP's. He averaged about 6 a season over his career, but in 2012 just happened not to hit into any. Any thoughts on what to do?

You may wonder how plump Pablo could be an average runner. He sure looks slow. He actually just squeaked into the A rating primarily due to his excellent stats on scoring from 2nd base on a single, making it $87 \%$ of the time while the league as a whole made it only $59 \%$. Sandoval actually was abysmal going 1st to 3rd on a single, making it only once in 25 chances. However, with only one run rating, a game engine decision for making the game easier to play, he gets to 3rd base at a league average rate, and he scores from 2nd on singles at a league average rate. If the game engine had dual ratings Sandoval would get $\mathrm{S} / \mathrm{F}$. That's not happening.
