- 1. **Choose Patient's Health Plan:** Click the Request Eligibility button to choose a patient's health plan.
- 2. View Patient's Current Medications: Locate the patient's current medications, along with the sig details on the right side. You may want to see them before prescribing a new medication. Use the maximize icon to view any completed details regarding current medications.

If you want to prescribe a medication from your current medications list, click the Select icon ⁽²⁾ and the medication will appear in the Drafts list grid below.

- 6. On the prescription screen, InSync's software will display the **Recommended Dose** on the right side. The **Alternatives** tab displays a list of alternative medications if you want to prescribe from that list.
- 7. Dosage Details: Once the medication is highlighted, select the dosage details.
- 8. Sig: Instructions are auto generated as per the dosage, unit, route and frequency of medication. You can also change instructions as desired.
 - a. **Do Not Fill Until**: If you do not want a pharmacy to refill medications before a specific date, select that date from this field.
 - b. **Sig Instructions to Pharmacy (language):** Choose the language (English or Spanish) from this drop-down to send the Pharmacy Notes.

- 10. Allergy: Locate the patient's allergies on the right side of the prescription screen. Click the icon to add new allergies.
- 11. Save: Once you enter the medication name in the Medication field, InSync's software automatically saves that medication to the system. You can view the saved medication in the grid. In case you change any default details, you need to click the Save button to apply the latest changes.
- 12. Save & Next: Once you add the medications that you want to prescribe, click Save & Next. This will take you to the new screen to transmit those medications to the pharmacy.

13. Interactions: You will see interactions, in the Drug-Drug, Drug-Allergy, Drug-Disease and Food Caution sections.

Note: There is a configuration available on the Prescriber Configuration screen if you want to show the interactions panel expanded or collapsed by default when you land on this screen. Also, if you want to restrict the users for major/moderate interactions before they proceed further, it can be done from the configuration screen.



2. **E-Prescription Role**: This drop-down list will show 4 types of roles. Each of the roles are explained below:

Doctor: This role will have full permissions for prescribing the medication.

Mid-Level Prescriber: This role will have permissions for prescribing the medication, however when the mid-level providers login to InSync, they will have to choose the Supervising Provider (with Doctor Role). When the medication is transmitted to Pharmacy, the Supervising Provider's (Doctor's) name will be printed on the prescription.

- Click the Patient Name link to access more details of that patient, such as Patient Demographics, Facesheet, To Do, and Prescribe/Manage.
- Select the medications from the list and click the Prescribe Medication icon ^R from the Header row to transmit all selected medications directly to the pharmacy. You will then be redirected to the Prescribe Medication screen.

Alternatively, you can also click the \mathbb{R}^{+} icon from the right side of each medication entry to transmit that medication individually.

- Click the Delete icon $\stackrel{\text{le}}{=}$ to delete the selected pending requests from the list.
- Click the Select/Change pharmacy icon $\stackrel{\text{\tiny def}}{=}$ to change the pharmacy for that medication.
- Medications for which pharmacies are not yet assigned will appear with an $\stackrel{2}{\cong}$ icon. Once you assign the pharmacy, the icon color will change to blue.



RENEWAL REQUESTS

The pharmacy renewal requests can also be accessed from the Dashboard by clicking the Renewal link under the eRx Status queue. By default, it shows the renewal requests of logged in provider.

- Click the 🖻 icon to show more details of that patient's record, such as Health summary report, encounter note, future appointments, current medications, and so forth.
- Click the Patient Name link to map the correct patient, if required.

Accept request

Click the Accept button to accept the renewal request. On the Accept refill renewal screen, you can view more details about the Patient, Pharmacy Request, Response, and Pharmacy Dispensed. Enter the refill quantity and click the Accept button to approve the request.

Deny Request

Click the Deny button to deny the renewal request. On the deny refill renewal screen, you can view more details about the Patient, Pharmacy Request, Response, and Pharmacy Dispensed. Select the suitable denial reason from the Denial Reason drop-down. Also, add a note regarding denial to pharmacy from the Note to Pharmacy field, if any. Click the Deny button to deny request.



CHANGE REQUESTS

The pharmacy change requests can also be accessed from Dashboard by clicking the Change link under the eRx Status queue. On the Pharmacy Change Medications screen, you can view the list of pharmacy change requests which were received from the pharmacy.

- Click the ⊕ icon to view a list of new medications requested by pharmacy instead of the medication you prescribed.
- Click the Edit icon \blacksquare to map the patient, if required.
- Select medications from the list and click the Accept button to accept the pharmacy request with new medications.
- Click the Accept with Changes button to accept pharmacy request with new medication but with different dose details.
- Click the Rewrite button to deny the refill request and generate the new prescription for the patient. Click the Deny button to deny the refill request received from the pharmacy.



GLOSSARY - FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH TERMINOLOGIES USED IN PRESCRIPTION MODULE BACK

To expedite the process of prescribing any medications, you must familiarize yourself with the terminology used in the prescription module.

1	Request Eligibility	Request real-time insurance eligibility for patient. When you access prescription module, first thing you do is, choose health plan for the patient. You can change the plan later, if required. The "Request Eligibility" button appears in the "Prescribe" tab.
2	Diagnosis	Record the diagnosis for which you are prescribing medication. In the "Prescribe" tab, choose the appropriate diagnosis from the drop-down list.
3	Favorite Medications	This feature lets you pick your favorite medications from the list to save your time. You can make the medication favorite after you prescribe it for the first time from the "Prescribe" tab.
4	Compound Medications Set	Configure and Prescribe Compound Medications by mixing individual ingredients together in the exact strength and dosage form as required by the patient.
5	Current Medications	Before you prescribe medication, look at the medications patient is currently taking. These are the medications you or any other provider may have prescribed in the past. You can record Current Medications from the "Manage" tab.
6	Alternatives	When you type in complete medication name, system populates a list of alternate medications. You can choose any of the alternate medications as a second option. Alternatives appear in the "Prescribe" tab. Make sure you have opted health plan for the patient.
7	Recommended Dose	When you type in complete medication name, system recommends the dose based on patient's age and gender. Recommended Dose appears in the "Prescribe" tab.
8	Rx History	Patient may have taken medications in past from other providers. Use this option to access patient's Rx history. Ensure that patient has not denied sharing Rx history from "Patient Details" screen.
9	A Pharmacy Communication Error Log	When pharmacies respond to prescriptions, they are captured on this screen. View pharmacy response on each medication having errors.
10	Sig Text + Frequency	Based on the dose details you select, Sig is printed for the patient.
11	Review & Transmit	When you save medications on the "Prescribe" tab and click Next, pointer is diverted to "Review & Transmit" page. You can then check the interactions, if any, and transmit the medications after review.



12	Manage Medications	Record the medications patient is currently taking.
13	Refill Requests	Manage refill requests sent by pharmacy.
14	Change Medications	Pharmacy may change your prescribed medication due to some reason and send back request with alternate medication for your approval.
15	Pending Medications	Medications only saved but not yet transmitted are stored as Pending Medications. Process them as and when required.
16	Admin Panel	Use Admin module for provider level permissions and EPCS setup.
