I SAW THE LORD



In Isaiah 6 we read about Isaiah's vision of the Lord. In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw also the Lord, sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; ... And one cried unto another and said, "Holy, holy holy is the Lord of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory." And the posts of the door moved at the voice of Him who cried, and the house was filled with smoke. Then said I, "Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man or

unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts."

I love this passage because it speaks so clearly to us about the glory, majesty, and holiness of our Lord and how "seeing" the Lord as He is, and not how we think He is, convicts us and can transform us in every situation. Verse 1 states that, "In the year that <u>King Uzziah died</u>", Isaiah saw the Lord. Judah experienced political difficulties, like the death of a king, just like every nation has through its existence. What we need today is what Isaiah needed, an encounter with the living God. Then and only then does everything else make sense. Isaiah saw the Lord and then he saw his own sin and was deeply grieved by it. He confessed his sin and was forgiven and restored to fulfill God's call on his life.

Friends, let's resort to the one thing that we know to do. Let's gaze at the Lord and let's glance at the trials and challenges surrounding us. Let's pray for each other that the Lord's Church would experience unity and power like never before, no matter which political party leads us. We are those who are called to follow the call of God by saying with Isaiah in verse 8, "Here am I; send me."
