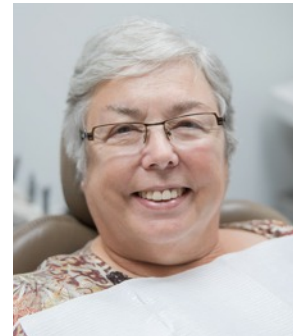

InterFaith Receives Landmark Grant from Humana Foundation

The Humana Foundation announced last month that InterFaith Health Clinic, in conjunction with collaborator Catapult 4D, would receive a \$1 million Strategic Community Investment in an effort to address social determinants of health and health equity barriers through innovative and creative technology in its *Truck2Table* pilot program. (**Note: InterFaith will only get to keep \$90,000 of this grant, with the remainder going to develop this innovative initiative. InterFaith's \$90,000 will be spent enrolling and assisting our patients and monitoring their success as this program impacts their health outcomes.**) "So often, when you make minimum wage, the opportunity to buy healthy foods does not exist," said InterFaith Executive Director Melissa Knight. "Truck2Table will aim to give patients better access to fresh and nutritious foods where they live, as well as provide human interaction to people who are socially isolated."

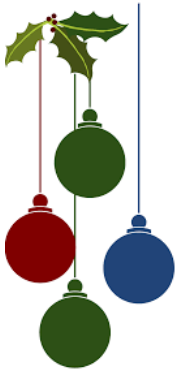
