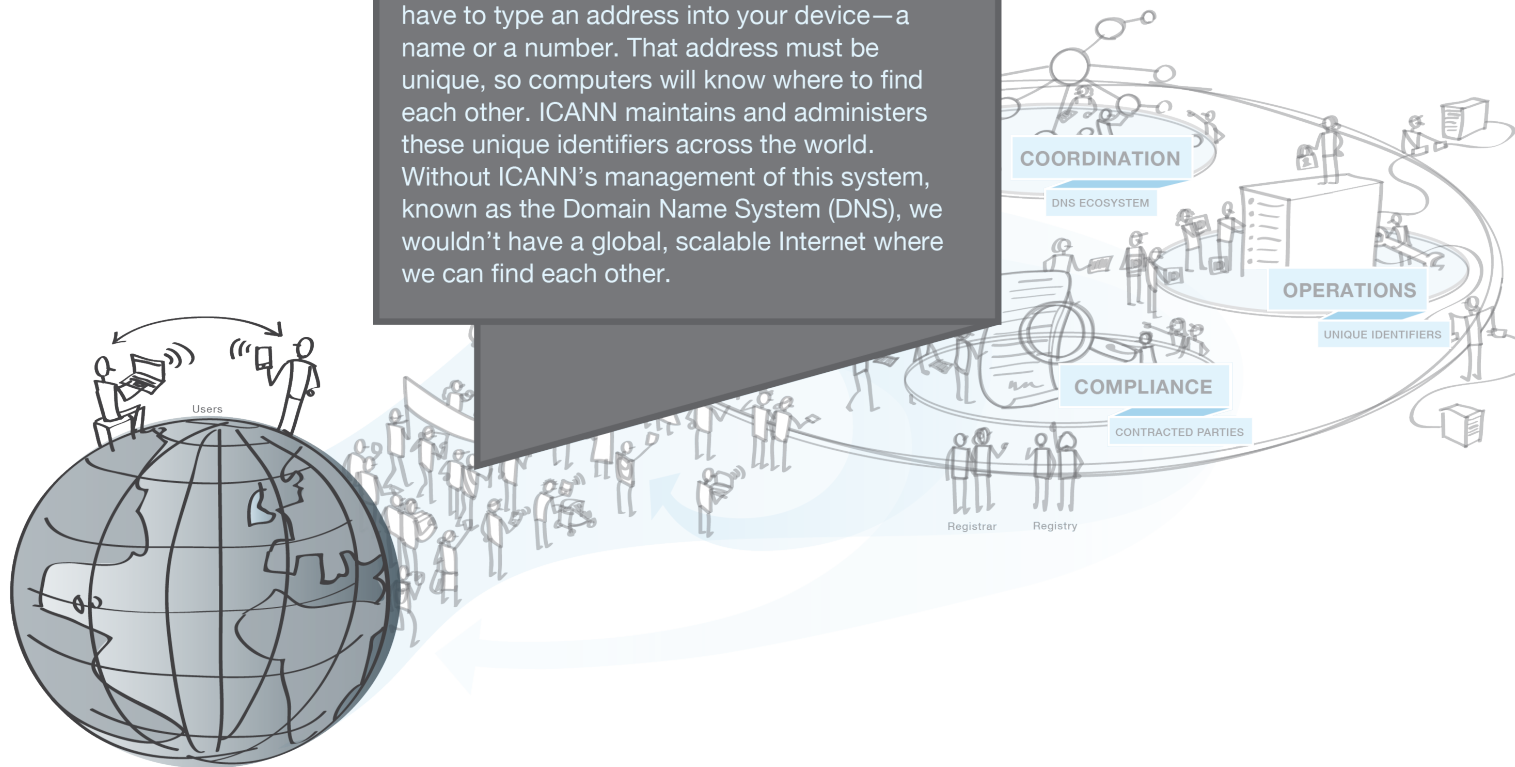

What does ICANN do?

WHAT DOES ICANN DO?

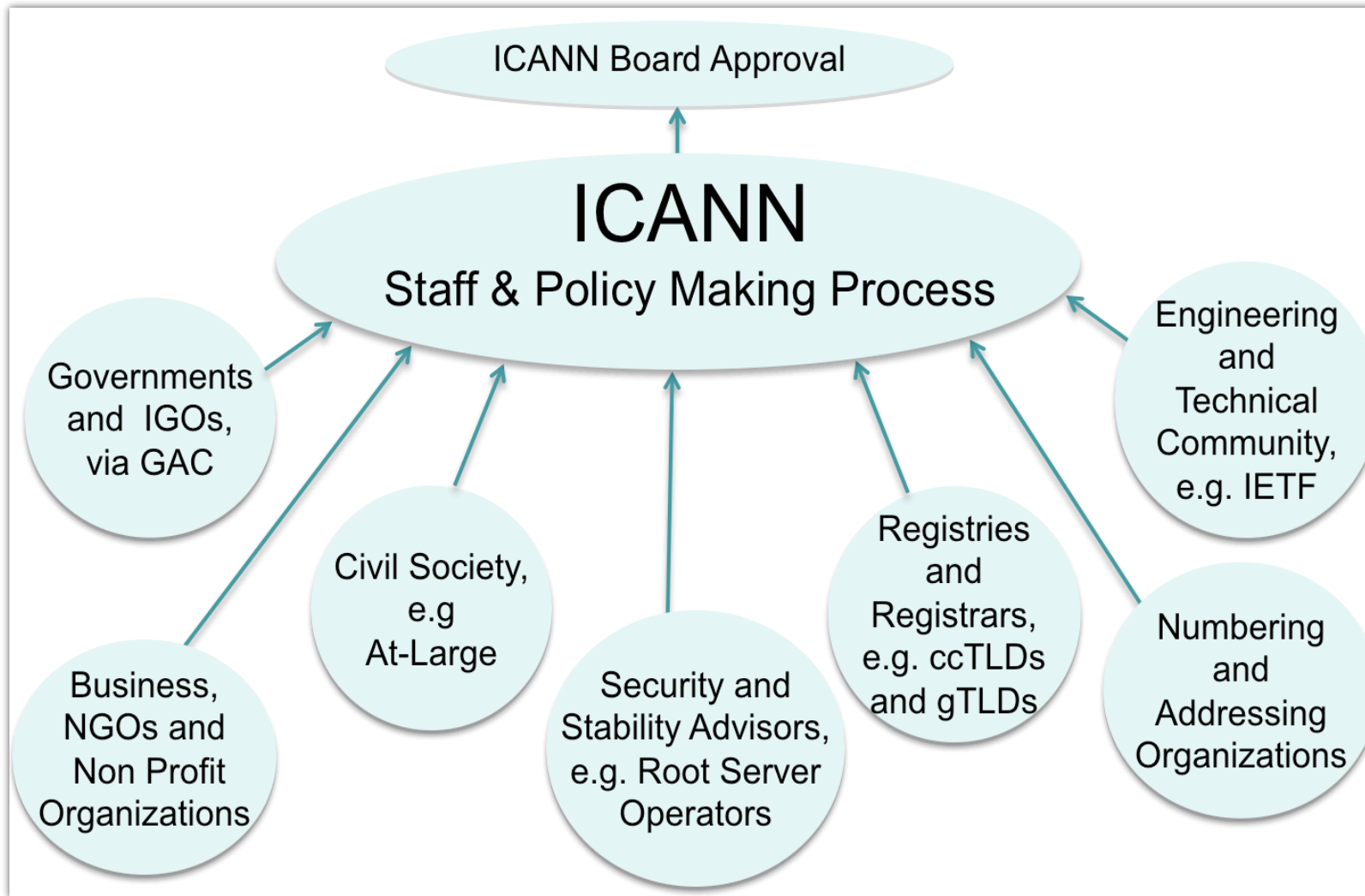
To reach another person on the Internet you have to type an address into your device—a name or a number. That address must be unique, so computers will know where to find each other. ICANN maintains and administers these unique identifiers across the world. Without ICANN's management of this system, known as the Domain Name System (DNS), we wouldn't have a global, scalable Internet where we can find each other.



Functions that ICANN Coordinates

- + Domain Name System (DNS)
- + Internet Protocol (IP) Address Allocation
- + Protocol-Parameter Registry
- + Root Server Systems
- + Generic Top-Level Domain Names (gTLD) system management
- + Country-code Top-Level Domain Name (ccTLD) DNS
- + Time Zone Database Management

3. Expansion of the Internet	Community education, At large structures, local initiatives and content	Seek partnership with regional and local NGOs, IGOs
4. Internet Governance	A sub-regional IGF, training for Govt, IANA stewardship discussion	Seek partnerships
