Approval of liturgical of texts



The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has approved on May 13, 2017 the liturgical texts for the Liturgy of the Hours in honor of **Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini**, confirming at the same time his liturgical

memory on **June 1st**, to be celebrated as a “Feast” wherever the Missionaries of St. Charles – Scalabrinians are present, and transferring the liturgical memory of Saint Justin, martyr (which also falls on the same day of June 1st, from the 1st to the 4th day of June). As soon as the translation of the above-mentioned liturgical texts in the four official languages of the Congregation will be completed, they will be sent to all confreres.

Authorization

The Holy See has authorized the Superior of the Province of St. Frances X. Cabrini to sell one of its properties located at 532 Bringelly Road – Sydney.

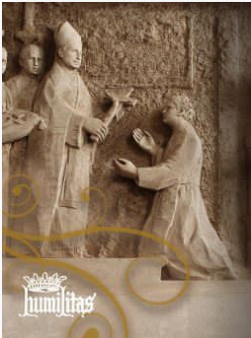

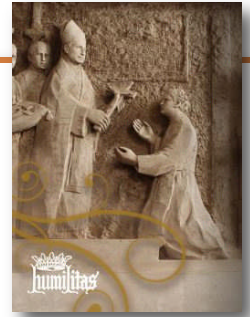

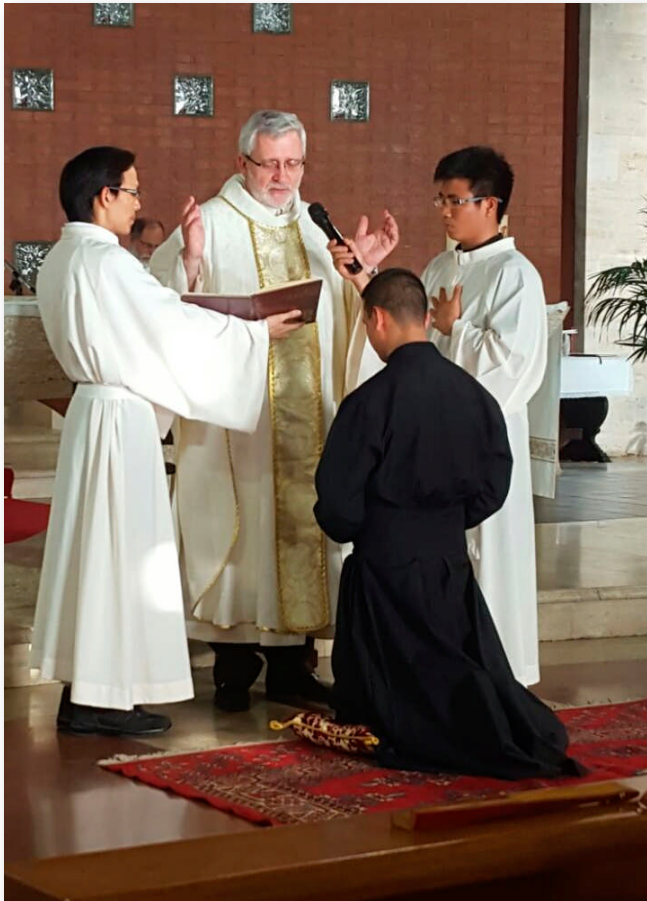
