Courses supported by VLE



Repository – quiz – timed access – communication tools – wiki – assignments etc.

A VLE typically consists of a CMS (Content Management System) and an LMS (Learning ent System). The CMS is the bank of learning materials on the VLE, from individual questions through to complete courses for learners. The LMS keeps a record of the learners who are enrolled on courses, their scores and their progress.
