Invitation:

EKA, a sports CSR initiative of IIFL Investment Managers, along with Indian Chess School & South Mumbai Chess Academy, cordially invites players from all chess federations under FIDE to participate in the 5th edition of IIFL Wealth Mumbai International Chess Tournament.

The championship is being conducted under the auspices of All India Chess Federation (AICF), All Marathi Chess Association (AMCA) & Mumbai City District Chess Association (MCDCA).

Eligibility:

The tournament is open for all the Under-13 players who are born on or after 01/01/2006 and will have to substantiate entries with valid Birth Certificates. Foreign participants would be permitted to participate against a valid FIDE ID.

Subject to fulfilling the age-criteria, the following players are invited to participate in this event and will be provided free entry only.

- 1. Boys & Girls who have secured top three rankings in the AICF National Chess Championships 2019 in Under-07, Under-09, Under-11 & Under-13.
- 2. The AICF 2019 National Schools Champions (One Boy & One Girl Player) in Under-06, Under-08, Under-10 & Under-12.
- 3. The 2019 State Champions (one Boy & one Girl player) of Maharashtra in Under-07, Under-09, Under-11 & Under-13.
- 4. The 2019 State Schools Champions (one Boy & one Girl player) of Maharashtra in Under-06, Under-08, Under-10 & Under-12.

Note:

- a) Players who fulfil the above categories should confirm their participation by 10th December, 2019.
- b) The benefit will not be passed to the next ranked player in case the eligible player is not in a position to participate.

















Trophies:

A total of 24 trophies (3 in each of the category separately for Boys & Girls) shall be awarded as under:

Note:

- 1. The age shall be reckoned as of 01st January 2019.
- 2. The category prizes in form of trophies to 3-Best Players in Under-07, 08, 09 & 10 shall be awarded only within the age-groups. For Example: a player under-07 shall not be eligible for U-08 prize and so on. The list of players in these categories would be displayed on the notice board after commencement of the tournament.
- 3. A player who has won a cash prize shall not be eligible for the age-category prize.

Mode of Remitting Entry Fee Payment:

The entry fee for the event is to be paid on-line on www.paychessentry.com.

Note:Last Date of Entry without late fee is 26 Dec 2019. After that Late Fee of ₹ 500/- will be charged.

Prize Money:

- 1. The prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only.
- 2. As per Income Tax regulations of India, tax shall be deducted at source (TDS) from the prize money awarded to the Foreign Players (@ 20.80%) & Indian players (@ 10% for the prize amount above the threshold of Rs.30,000/- and above).
- 3. All Indian players above are required to submit a copy of the PAN card and AADHAR card. For players who fail to submit a PAN card, TDS would be deducted @ 20.80% irrespective of the prize money won.
- 4. All payments to Indian players would be made by cheque and will be issued in the name of the concerned prize winner only.
- 5. Payment of prize money awarded to foreign players would be made by SWIFT to their bank accounts.
- 6. Prize winners from foreign countries would be required to submit a copy of their passport, visa and air-tickets.

AICF Registration 2019-2020 for Indian Players:

Indian players should be compulsory registered with AICF. Players not yet registered can do so by remitting a sum of Rs.250/- online on www.aicf.in. Entries from unregistered players will not be entertained.

AMCA Registration 2019-2020 for Players from the State of Maharashtra:

Maharashtra players must be registered with AMCA. Players not yet registered can do so by remitting a sum of Rs.150/- online on www.mahachess.com. Entries from unregistered players will not be entertained.

Default Time:

Any player who is not present at the schedule start of the round shall be forced to forfeit the game. Thus, the default time is 0 minutes.

The Drawn Game:

The rules of the competition specify that the players cannot draw the game before 40 moves without the consent of the Arbiter.

Tie-Break:

The following tie-break criteria shall be applied (in the order given) to determine the final rankings:

- 1. Results of direct encounters between the tied players
- 2. Buchholz Cut 1
- 3. Buchholz
- 4. The greater number of games played with Black
- 5. The greater number of wins

Arbitration of Protest:

Objection, if any, to the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/-(Rs. Five Hundred Only) within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount would be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee:

A 7-member Committee of Appeals (inclusive of 2-reserves) shall be formed from amongst players/Officials/Coaches. The decision of the said committee shall be final and binding on all the participants.

Interpretation:

For further interpretations of the rule(s) and deciding any aspect not covered by the said tournament prospectus, the decision of the Tournament Directors shall be final and binding on all the participants. The Tournament Director has every right to make any addition/deletion/amendment to these rules. However, such changes shall be displayed on the notice board.
