It has been five weeks since I began reflecting on the papal Bulletin Misericordiae Vultus and, as you have been so patiently reading these bulletin articles, my hope is that through reading them you yourself are becoming more deeply immersed in the mercy and the love of Jesus Christ.

The fifth paragraph states: ***“May the balm of mercy reach everyone, both believers and those far away, as a sign that the kingdom of God is already present in our midst!”*** I would like to reflect on the phrase: “... ***the balm of mercy...***” As your pastor, I always want to

show to you the love of Jesus Christ; however, I am also

the grateful recipient of His mercy by how you live your lives and how you interact with me and with each other.

A wonderful example of this ***“balm of mercy*** is the Society of Mother Teresa meal program and the Immaculate Conception Food Pantry at McKinley Center, as well as the St. Vincent DePaul Society. The countless men and women who volunteer time, talent, and treasure to aid and assist those who are in need is an expression of the ***“balm of mercy”*** freely shared with our brothers and sisters who are in need. Another example is the men and women who pray in our Eucharistic Chapel. These men and women pray daily for the needs of our parish community and for the whole world. They desire that this ***“balm of mercy”*** fill the hearts of every person in our community and beyond. One additional example is the men and women who serve as extraordinary ministers and bring Holy Communion to our brothers and sisters. These men and women bring the Holy Eucharist to those who cannot come to Mass due to illness. Our homebound are thus able to experience the ***“balm of mercy”*** as the Lord’s Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity is brought to them.



My brothers and sisters, each and every one of us must be the ***“balm of mercy”*** to the world. This week, as we think about this expression ask yourself one question: “What can I do to bring the mercy of God to others?” I have offered three examples but be sure to ask the Holy Spirit to guide you and open your eyes and your hearts to the myriad of other ways available to us. We are called to bring the mercy of the Lord to the whole world!

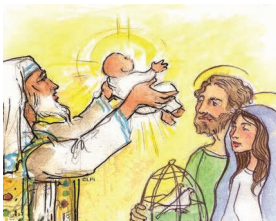

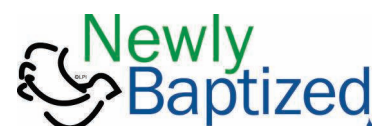

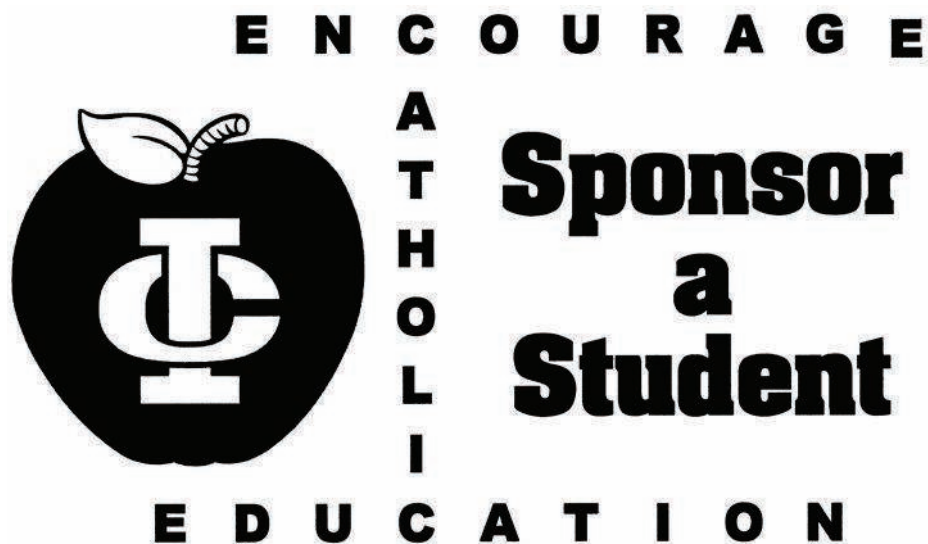
