**Prepare For Next Sunday’s Readings**

*Next Sunday’s Gospel, (Sept. 26) the demon possession described might be seen as a form of mental illness, but the need for healing these syndromes was as real then as it is now. Exorcism was a common practice in first-century Palestine. Some people had the power to heal the symptoms of possession. The disciples observed that the unknown exorcist invoked Jesus’ name and was successful in his healing efforts. This unknown healer recognized the power of Jesus’ name, yet he was not a follower of Jesus. In his reply to his disciples, Jesus acknowledges that deeds of faith can precede the words of faith. He also teaches that the disciples should not be reluctant to share Jesus’ healing powers with others. Jesus teaches us not to create obstacles for those who are just beginning to have faith but to encourage even the smallest signs of faith. Jesus teaches his disciples the consequences to those who would put obstacles before people who are on the road to faith.*

A Pilgrim's Progress . . . . .

This week I will join the priests of the diocese at our annual convocation with Bishop Paprocki to be held in Collinsville.

Our speaker this year is Professor John Bergsma from Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio. He will be focusing on Jesus and the Dead Sea Scrolls. There will be no parish masses at St. Columcille or Immaculate Conception on Tuesday or Wednesday.

This is also usually about the time we get an annual letter from Bishop Paprocki inviting our support of the Annual Catholic Services Appeal to fund seminarian education, Catholic outreach on our college campuses, and all the other ministries of the diocese. Our parishioners have generously supported this appeal over the years. It has now been replaced by the Parish Community Tithe.

The Parish Tithe to the diocese means that each month we forward 10% of our regular parish income to support our diocesan ministries. This means the donations previously given by our parish households directly to the diocese now come from the parish itself. If parishioners generously give directly to the parish the donations previously sent to the diocese this new system will work well. If this does not happen our parishes will fall behind in the income we receive to meet our local needs.

Thank you for all the ways you generously give of your time, talent, and financial sacrifices not only for our parish and diocesan ministries but so many worthwhile community outreaches as well.

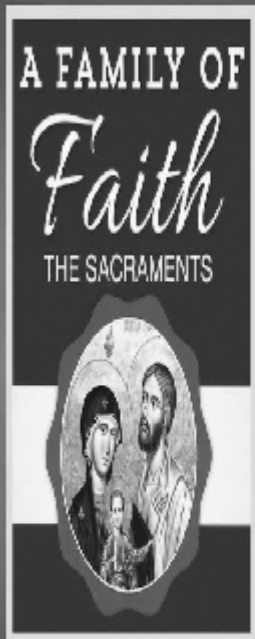
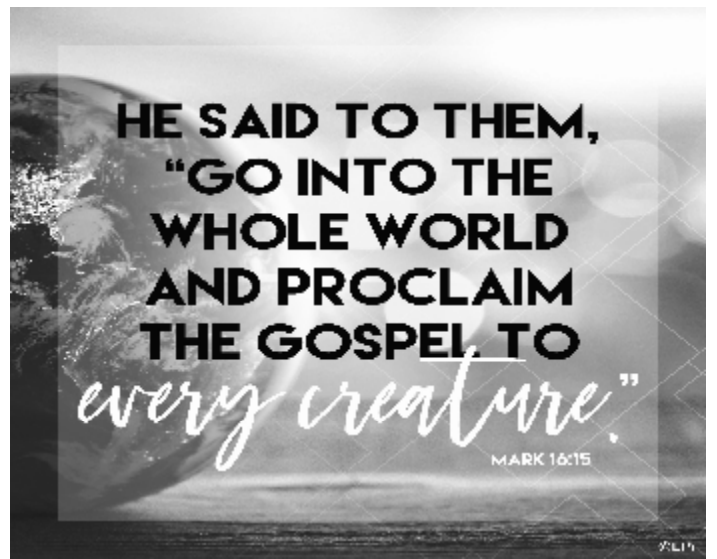

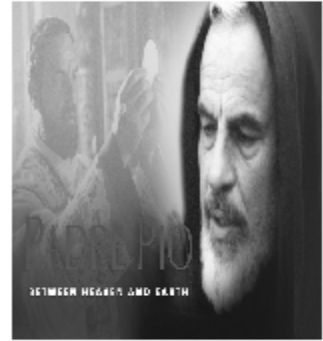
