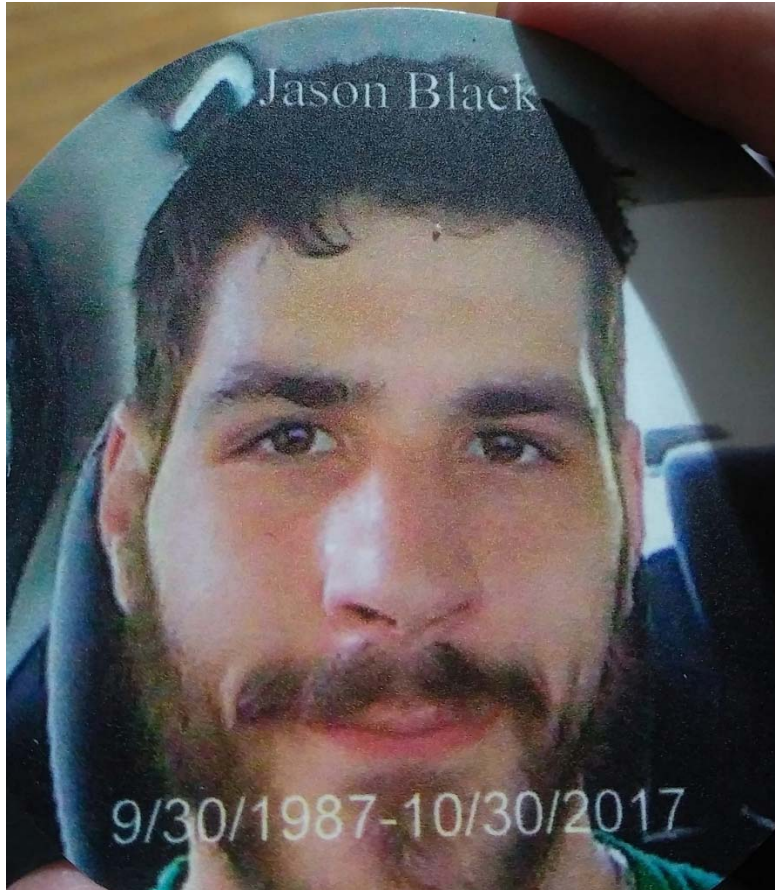

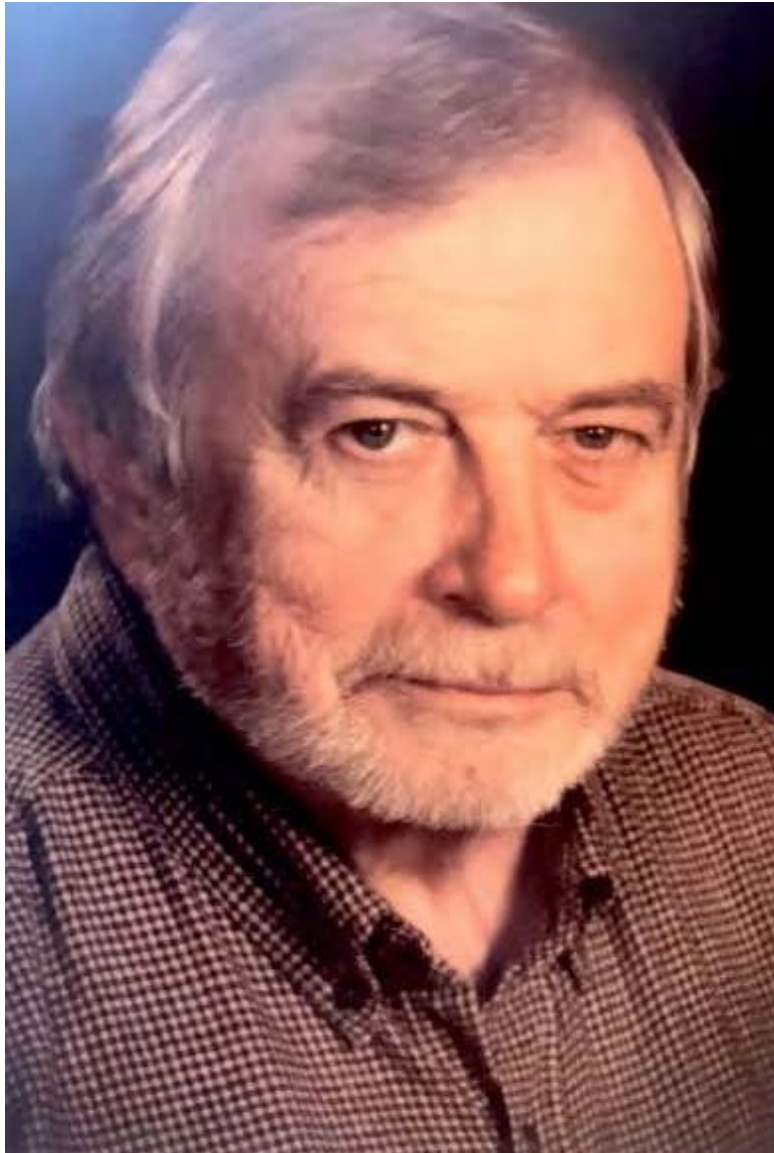
A week before he passed away, angel wing birthmarks appeared on his back. He was the best son and baby brother we could ever have and we miss him every second.

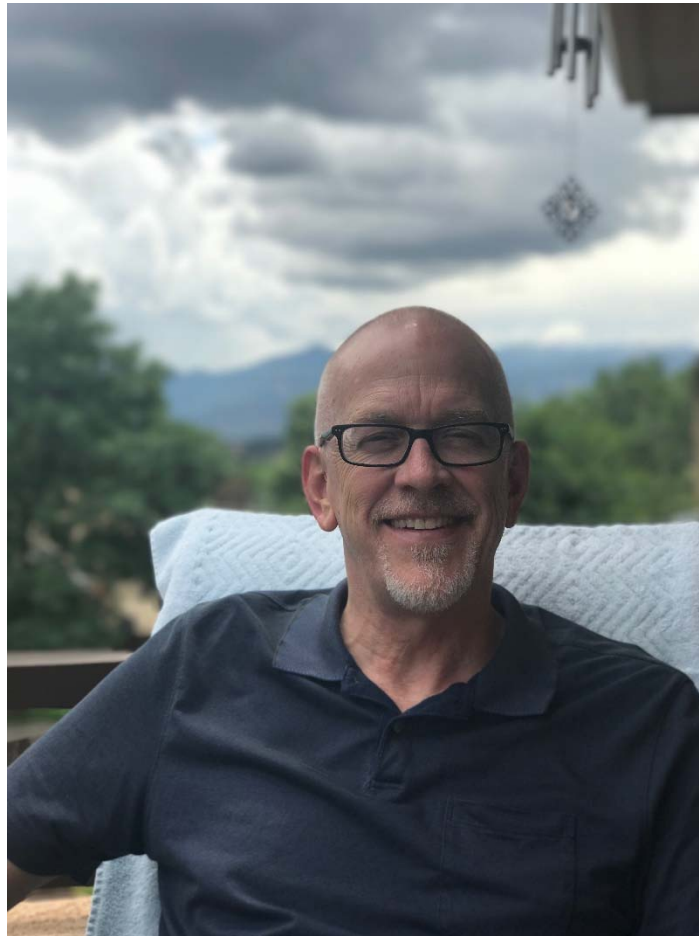

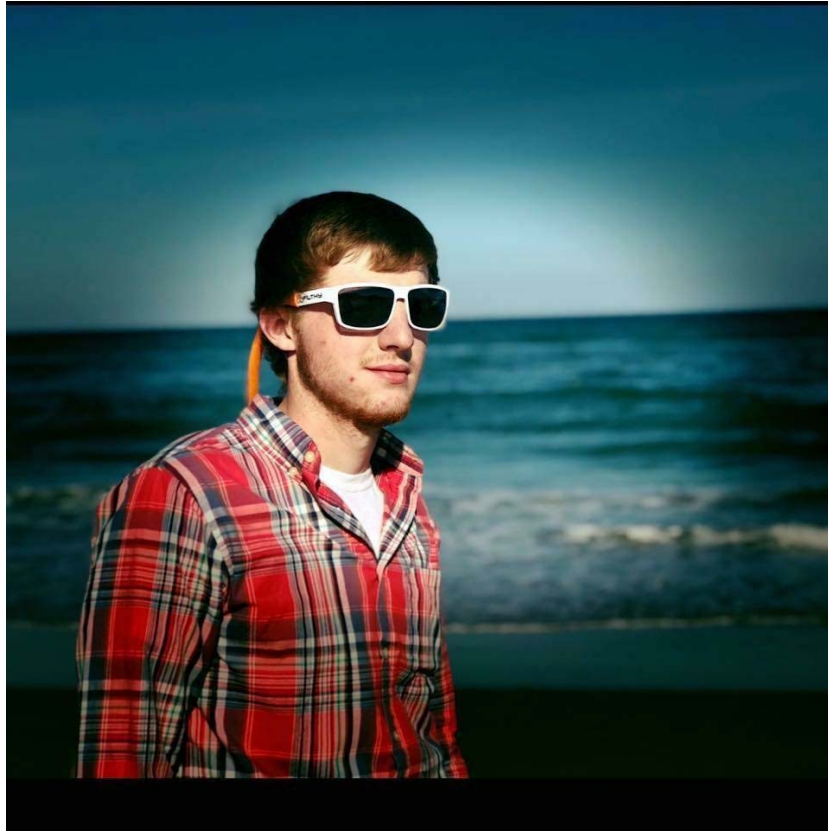
Cody had the biggest heart. He wanted to help everyone. He loved t-ball and playing with his friends.

Gone but never forgotten.



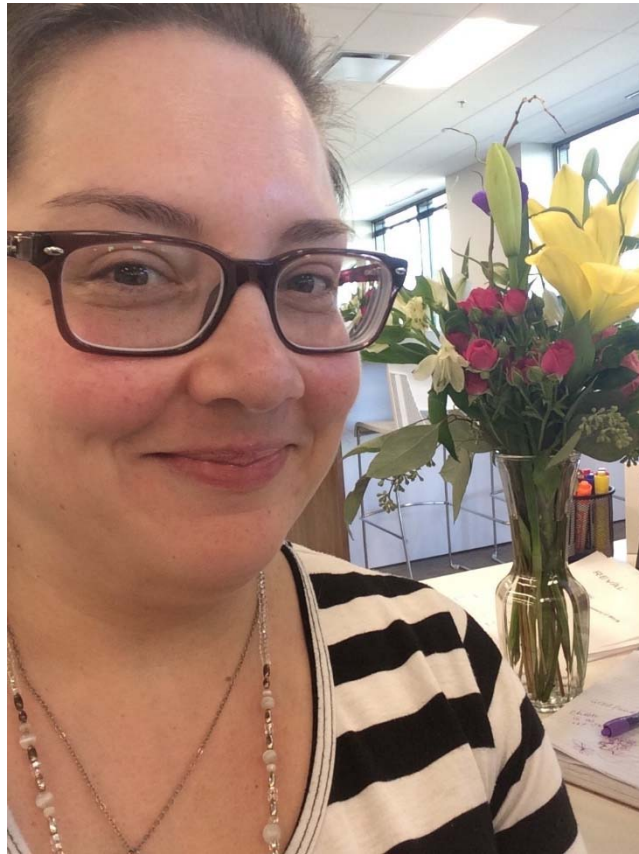

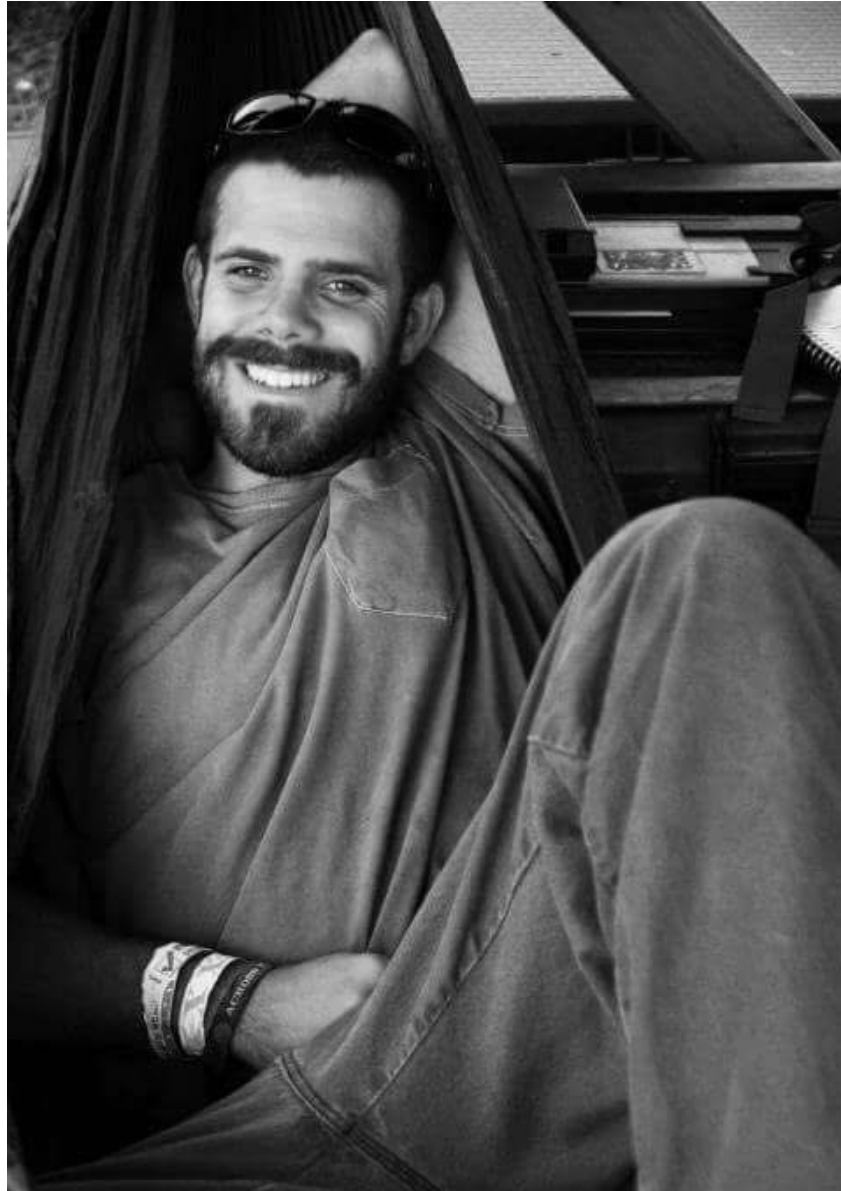

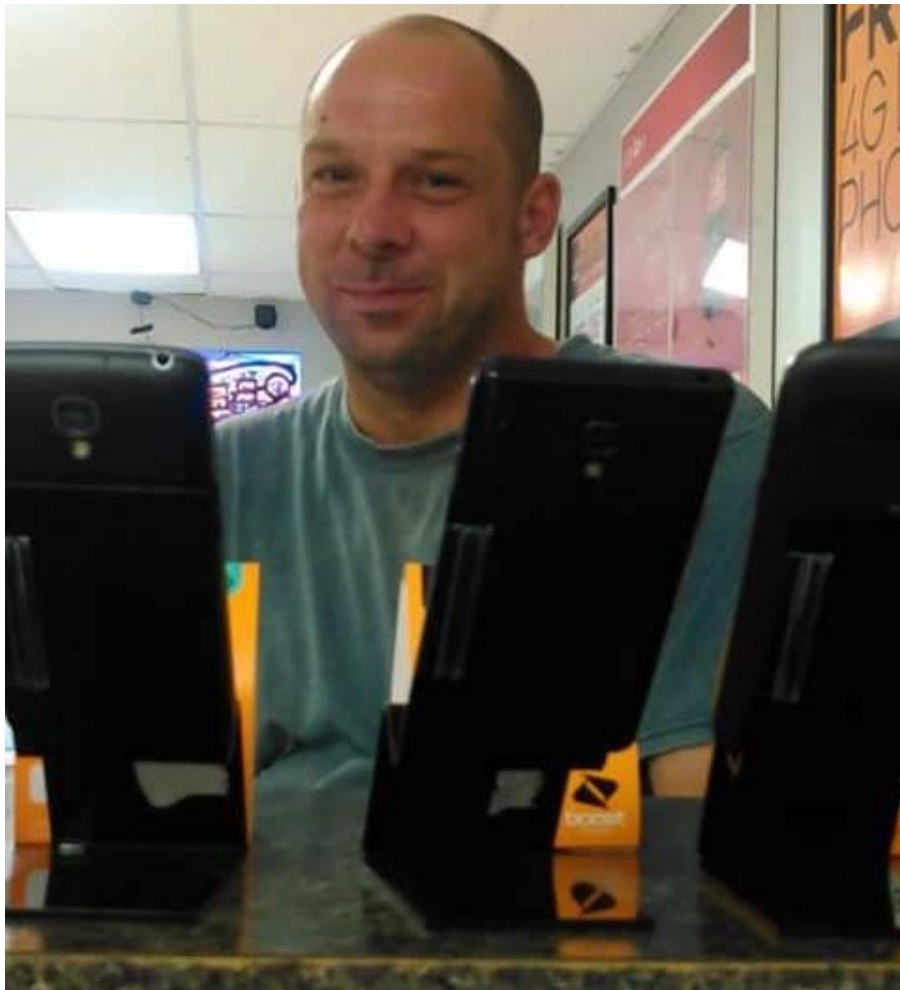
Ricky Brandon Owens

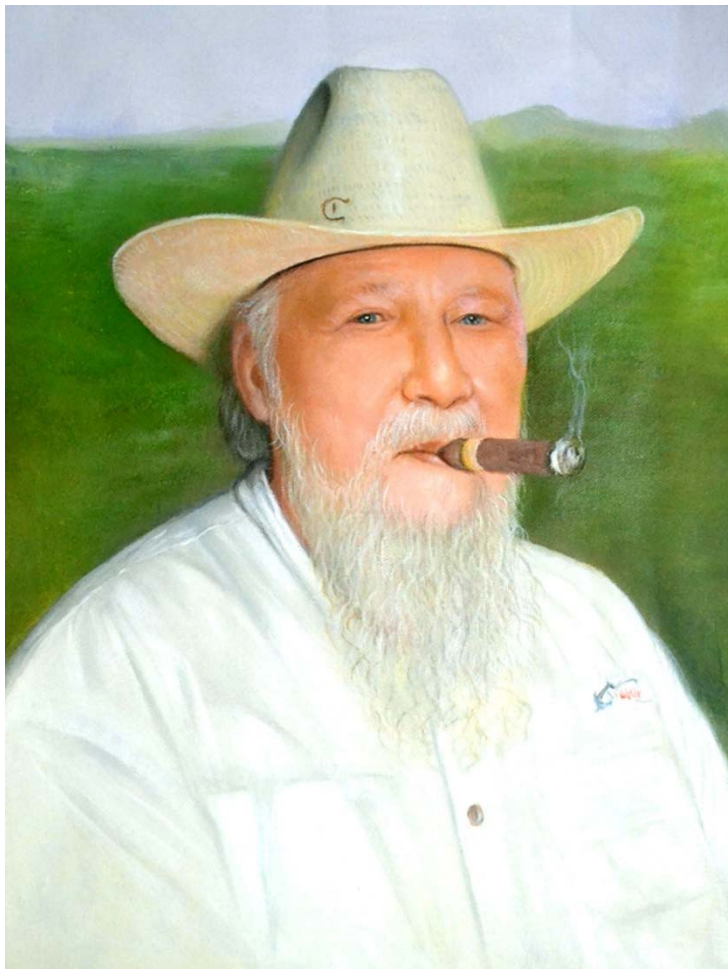
