

Her work has been seen internationally through the 10th Pan Am Games Opening Ceremony for CBS/Disney and has been recognized with a Decatur Herald and 2 Emmy Awards. Millie resides in her hometown, St. Louis with her husband of 15 years, Whit Reichert.

JR McAlexander - Musical Director

JR is delighted to return for his fourth season as musical director of The Little Theatre On The Square. 


